3. FEATHER RIVER CENTER AGREEMENT No. 3280 REQUEST TO REALLOCATE REMAINING FUNDS

The SBF Steering Committee will receive updated information regarding the 2018 NOFA Agreement No. 3280 with Feather River Center (FRC) and consider a reallocation of the remaining grant funds.

4. FEATHER RIVER RECREATION PARK DISTRICT (FRRPD) GRANT #3270 EXTENSION/BRAD FREEMAN TRAIL

The SBF Steering Committee will consider extending the grant previously issued on January 16, 2019, to FRRPD for completion of the remaining unimproved portion of the Brad Freeman Trail below the Oroville Veterans Memorial to the Feather River Nature Center. The grant initially in the amount of \$260,760.00 has a currently available balance of \$237,299.59.

6. REQUEST FROM OROVILLE AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TO EXTEND THE MATURITY OF SBF GRANT NO 3243-4

The Oroville Area Chamber of Commerce (Chamber) has requested to extend the maturity of grant No3243-4 which was previously approved on July 28, 2021 in the amount of \$30,000 for Tourism and Marketing Activities. A four-month extension expiring December 31, 2022 is requested. The extension will allow upcoming events such as the Salmon Festival and the Oroville Parade of Lights to be advertised on electronic billboards.
