Approve Draft Minutes: Peter Gulbranson made a motion to approve. John Branigin seconded. Motion passed.

Shawn Gillen and Joel Fobes went through the CIP for TIPD, with a focus on big ticket items.

Monty Parks and Shawn Gillen spoke about the number of squad cars we need. Joel Fobes spoke about the details, along with Shawn Gillen, regarding the Enterprise lease program.
