SUMMARY

On May 1, 2023, the Oroville Arts Commission released a 2023 Beautification Notice of Funds Available in the amount of \$40,000 for two separate locations. The application period closed on May 31, 2023, with no applications received.

DISCUSSION

The commission requested staff to release a NOFA for the locations of Montgomery Street roundabout and Martin Luther King Jr. Park and Wyandotte Avenue. The NOFA was released May 1st, for 30 days on the city’s webpage and social media. Staff received no applications.

Staff suggest releasing the NOFA for an additional 30-days and all qualifying submissions will be reviewed and selected by the Oroville Arts Commission and taken to City Council for final approval.

With several upcoming construction projects staff expects an increase in the Art in Public Places fund. Until that time, the balance of Art in Public Places funding will be used for the Table Mountain Blvd. Art Wall allocation.

FISCAL IMPACT

Fund Balance \$91,392.46, use of \$50,000 on Art Wall, remaining balance of \$41,392.46
