Letter of Award Recommendation

Dear Mayor Wallace:

Bids were publicly opened and read on March 16, 2021 for the above-referenced project. As reflected on the attached Bid Tabulation, six (6) bids were received. The lowest bidder was Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC. During the review of the bidder's qualifications concerns arose regarding the project references and project financial information provided by Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC. As requested by City Council at the April 21, 2021 meeting, Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC has submitted supplemental project and financial information and our office has completed an evaluation and verification of the supplementary information.

Our office spoke with the supplied project references and inquired about the performance of Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC. Two parties for one of the references provided an elaboration on the paving portion of the project that Forsythe completed for them. Forsythe used the same subcontractor for the reference paving project that they are proposing to use for the 2020 Capital Metro project. The reference had no issues or complaints with the work performed on the project. An additional project reference was provided for a drainage repair project. The project included removal of existing undersized pipes and replacing them with new box culverts. The project work consisted of daily oneway traffic control, removal and replacement of pipes, installation of safety end treatments and minor pavement work.

Bank account information was provided for review by Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC for several additional accounts. It was previously noted that Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, Inc. did not submit any credit sources for either their bank or material vendors. While no credit references were submitted with the supplementary information, financial account information was provided and indicates that Forsythe Brother's LLC appears to possess the financial capacity to complete the project.

As City Engineer, we typically rely upon well-demonstrated experience in a given specialty and credit limits sufficient to ensure adequate purchasing capacity for project materials and equipment to support a recommendation for award of a construction contract. At the City Council's request however, we have conducted evaluations of the contractor's supplementary qualifications information and can state that although the contractor has limited experience with paving projects, they possess some demonstrated work experience that has proven sufficient in other jurisdictions. And, although the





contractor has no credit with their financial institutions or materials suppliers, they have demonstrated via submittal of additional financial information that they presently have sufficient financial reserves to pay for the necessary project materials.

Following our review of the supplemental contractor qualification information, we can therefore conditionally recommend the City award a construction contract to Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC. in the amount of \$374,188.75 for all Base Bid and Alternate Bid work, with final amounts dependent on actual installed quantities, acknowledging that there is some limited risk to the City making award based upon the nature and extent of the submitted qualifications materials.

We have prepared an Agreement for signature by you in the event the City Council votes to follow this recommendation. Once the Contractor signs the Agreement and all bond and insurance requirements have been satisfied, a Notice to Proceed will be issued. Under the General Conditions of the Agreement, the Contractor shall begin construction within ten (10) days of the Notice to Proceed and substantially complete the project within one hundred and fifty (150) calendar days, excluding any justified delays.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this <u>27th day of April, AD 2021</u>, by and between the City of Manor, Texas, a home-rule municipal corporation, with principal offices located at 105 E. Eggleston St., Manor, Texas 78653, hereinafter termed OWNER, or CITY and <u>Forsythe Brothers Infrastructure, LLC</u> a corporation, with principal offices located at <u>309 West</u> Lane Street, Manor, Texas 78653, hereinafter termed CONTRACTOR.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the mutual terms, conditions, and covenants of this Agreement and the accompanying documents between Owner and Contractor and for and in consideration of payments as set forth therein, Contractor hereby agrees with the said Owner to commence and complete the following Project:

2020 CAPITAL METRO PAVING IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY OF MANOR, TEXAS FOR ALL BASE BID AND ALTERNATE BID WORK

and all extra work in connection therewith, under the terms as stated in the Contract Documents and at CONTRACTOR's own proper cost and expense to furnish all the materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, tools, superintendence, labor, insurance, and other accessories and services necessary to construct and complete 2020 CAPITAL METRO PAVING IMPROVEMENTS (the "Project" or "Work"), in accordance with the Contractor's Proposal, Instructions to Bidders, Special Provisions, Supplementary Conditions, General Conditions, Performance bond, Payment bond, Drawings, Plans and Technical Specifications and other drawings and printed or written explanatory matter thereof, and the addenda therefore, as prepared by Jay Engineering, a Division of GBA herein entitled the ENGINEER, and approved by the OWNER, all of which are made a part hereof and collectively evidence and constitute the entire contract (the "Contract Documents").

The CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to commence work within ten (10) days after the date written notice to do so shall have been given to him, and to substantially complete work within:

<u>Base Bid work – ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY (120) calendar days for substantial completion of work.</u>

Base Bid and Alternate Bids 'A', 'B', 'C', 'D' and 'E' – ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY (150) calendar days for substantial completion of work.

after the date specified in the written Notice to Proceed.

Waiver of any breach of this Agreement shall not constitute waiver of any subsequent breach.

The OWNER agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR, for satisfactory performance of this Agreement, in current funds the price or prices shown in the Contractor's Proposal, which forms a part of this contract, such payments to be subject to proper completion of the contract, in the total amount of \$392,990.00 (THREE HUNDRED NINETY-TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY-NINE DOLLARS) subject to proper additions and deductions (the "Contract Amount"), all as provided in the General Conditions of this Agreement. The financial obligations of the City under this Agreement shall be paid from current funds and shall be subject to funds being appropriated and budgeted in sufficient amounts to satisfy such obligations.

Although drawn by the OWNER, both parties hereto expressly agree and assert that in the event of any dispute over its meaning or application, this Agreement shall be interpreted reasonably and fairly, and neither more strongly for nor against either party.

The CONTRACTOR agrees that time is of the essence on this contract and that for each calendar day of delay beyond the time established for completion of the work specified and contracted for, the Owner may withhold permanently from the CONTRATOR'S compensation the sum of <u>Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00</u>) as stipulated liquidated damages for delay.

In accordance with Chapter 2270, Texas Government Code, the CITY may not enter into a contract with a company for goods and services unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it: (a) does not boycott Israel; and (2) will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract. The signatory executing this contract on behalf of the company verifies that CONTRACTOR does not boycott Israel and will not boycott Israel during the term of this Agreement.

To the extent this Agreement constitutes a governmental contract within the meaning of Section 2252.151 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, solely for purposes of compliance with Chapter 2252 of the Texas Government Code, and except to the extent otherwise required by applicable federal law, CONTRACTOR represents that CONTRACTOR nor any wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of CONTRACTOR is a company listed by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Sections 2270.0201, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, both parties have caused this Agreement to be signed in their respective corporate names by duly authorized representatives, and the parties hereby bind themselves, their successors and assigns for the faithful and full performance of the terms and provisions hereof.
