City of Bay City Health Plan Benefits Executive Summary

Plan Year 2024-2025:

Our benefits consultant, McGriff, went to the market for our annual health insurance renewal. The City received bids from BCBS, Aetna, UHC, and Curative Health. UHC emerged as the most competitive (among the listed), offering an overall premium reduction of 5% for plans similar to our current plan makeup. BCBS, our current provider, initially proposed a 9.4% renewal increase, but McGriff used the UHC bid to negotiate this down to a 0% increase.

Meanwhile, the City has been working with the TX Health Benefits Pool (TML) to potentially join their benefits pool. On July 17, 2024, the City received a highly favorable proposal from TML, offering the highest rate reduction with an estimated overall decrease of 16.2%. This proposal would streamline our medical plan options from three to two: HMO and PPO. Both plans offer richer benefits compared to our current plans. It has been a long journey for the City to finally be in a position to join the Pool.

For this, we recommend a dual option that includes the HMO-3K-6K Plan, which offers an In-Network Deductible of \$3,000 for covered members along with the Copay-3K-7K ER Plan, which offers an In-Network deductible of \$3,000 for covered members.

Our Copay Plans help make care accessible as quickly as possible, by providing copays for services such as primary doctor visits or urgent care visits rather than the employee having to first hit their deductible.

Our new HMO Plans help keep out of pocket costs low for you and your employees by emphasizing primary care, with specialists available by referral.

Lower Prescription Costs for Your Employees and their Families

To help public servants like you access affordable healthcare, we work to relieve the burden of medication costs, with:

- \$0 Copay for select diabetes, hypertension, and cholesterol medications.
- \$10 Copay for most other Generic Drugs.

The Best Provider Network in Texas

Your employees should be able to leave their own backyard and still be covered. Members have statewide access to in-network coverage through the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas network, the widest network in Texas. Members that elect the PPO option will have access to the Blue Choice PPO network. When enrolled in an HMO, Members will have access to the Blue Essentials network. Rafting at Yellowstone?
