

Overview/Operations

- MET provides public transportation for the citizens of the urbanized area of Black Hawk County.
- Funding through the FTA, Iowa DOT and Local.
- MET is a separate entity from the Cities of Waterloo and Cedar Falls that operates through a 28E agreement.
- Operate two types of service
 - Fixed route service Traditional public transit bus service. Waterloo and Cedar Falls
 - Paratransit service ADA and elderly door-to-door service for those that are unable to utilize the fixed route system. Waterloo, Cedar Falls and Evansdale.

- 7 routes Waterloo
- 1 route Cedar Falls
- 2 routes Waterloo/Cedar Falls
- 1 route HCC/UNI



Fixed Route Ridership (system wide)


- FY24 = 190,997 (+9%)
- FY23 = 174,150 (+0.2%)
- FY22 = 173,738 (+14%)
- FY21 = 152,992 (-46%)
- FY20 = 284,926 (-14.0% Covid - last 4 months of fiscal year)
- FY19 = 330,047

Route 6 Route 7 Route 9




Paratransit Service

Average 14 Routes per weekday Average 4 Routes on Saturdays



Daily Rides - Paratransit

- FY24 = 42,730 (+0.9%)
- FY23 = 42,320 (+3%)
- FY22 = 41,051 (+13%)
- FY21 = 36,272 (-27.5%)
- FY20 = 50,051 (-6.8% Covid - last 4 months of fiscal year)
- FY19 = 53,687



Route Restructuring Initiative

- Fixed routes due for updates
- Old traditional 1 hour circular routes
- Routes will travel in two directions (out and back), instead of large loops
- Shorter travel times
- More transfer options
- Increase ridership
- Same service hours

Transit Study

- Route Restructuring Evaluation
 - Service areas
 - Frequency of service/shorter travel times
 - Increase ridership
- Fares (fare structure analysis, zero-fare system analysis)
- Fleet Transition Plan Zero Emissions
 - Facility upgrades
 - Low/no emissions
 - Bus fleet electric, natural gas, etc.
 - Roof top solar power
 - Bus stop amenities

MET Transit

- Ecolane web-based scheduling software and use of on-board mobile data terminals in Paratransit
- Unite GPS real time bus tracking solution for Fixed Route service
- Remix transit planning software
- Cooperative efforts to develop/improve bus stops and shelters in connection with street reconstruction projects

Additional Transit Services

- Micro transit demand response
- Rideshare/Carpooling
- Deviated fixed route hybrid of fixed route and demand response
- Uber/Lyft/Taxi Service to transport passengers to predetermined fixed route locations.
- School rides UNI, HCC, School District

Challenges

- Increase Cost for Bus Replacement
- Fixed Service Requests
 Expanded Coverage
 Expanded Hours
- Charter Regulations
- Driver workforce
