ANALYSIS:

Option 1 in the amount of \$1,962.91 to restore power: if this fails, we will perform option 2. We will dig up the area where the line was cut, install junction box and refeed circuits to restore power to monument lights and outlets, and we will resecure the meter base and panel that has detached from wall

Option 2 in the amount of \$6,655.36 if option 1 fails to restore power: we will trench/ bore from existing power source to monument area and install conduit, refeed circuits to restore power to monument lights and outlets, and resecure the meter base and panel that has detached from wall




