of Alcohol," be and are hereby lifted for the Ghouley Pub Crawl beginning on October 26,

2019, at 3:00 p.m. through 2:00 a.m. on October 27, 2019, within the confines of the following

areas:

• Mechanic at Bedford Street south to Harrison Street;

• Harrison East to Queen City Drive

• Queen City Drive north to Baltimore Street;

• Baltimore Street west to George Street;

• George Street north to Butler Alley;

• Butler Alley to Frederick and Bedford Streets by way of Centre Street;

• with extensions to Queen City Pavement / Gulf Memorial Drive.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, open glass containers shall not be permitted in the area

defined above and Section 11-113 (a) of the City Code shall remain in force and effect as to

glass open containers of alcoholic beverages in that area.
