Citizens and other visitors attending MYAC meetings shall observe the same rules of propriety, decorum, and good conduct applicable to members of the MYAC. Any person making personal, impertinent, profane or slanderous remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the MYAC or while attending the meeting shall be removed from the room, if so directed by the Mayor or presiding officer, and the person shall be barred from further audience before the MYAC during that session of the meeting. Disruption of a public meeting could constitute a violation of Section 42.05 of the Texas Penal Code.

1. Call to Order / Ice Breaker (MP) The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m.

2. Administer Oaths of Office to members of the Mayor's Youth Advisory Council (MLS)

Town Secretary, Ms. Lewis Sirianni administered the oaths of office to members of the Mayors Youth Advisory Council.

3. Welcome and Introductions – Mayor David Bristol (DFB)

Mayor Bristol welcomed the council members and asked the returning council members why they applied again after the inaugural class. Mr. He mentioned he

enjoyed getting to meet other people and learn about local government. Ms. Richardson talked about how she liked the volunteer opportunities available. Mr. Beitel also mentioned how he enjoyed learning more about local government. Mr. Church enjoyed the collaborative effort with the first council and how he hopes to do the same this year.

4. Town of Prosper Governance – Mayor David Bristol (DFB)

Mayor David Bristol gave an overview of the Town of Prosper governance including the Home Rule Charter, ordinances, Town Council roles and responsibilities, and strategic vision. Mayor Bristol's goal is for the youth of Prosper to become more educated on local government and how it operates so that they may be more informed and engaged citizens.

5. Town of Prosper Operations – Mario Canizares, Town Manager (MC) Town Manager, Mario Canizares presented a high-level overview of the Town of Prosper operations, giving the students a look behind the curtain of the different functions and aspects of local government. Several topics were covered including the special responsibilities that local governments have along with how they use resources and provide services. Mario also covered the Town of Prosper's organizational chart and staff relations.

6. MYAC Scope & Purpose Discussion – Todd Rice, Communications Director (TR)

Mr. Rice, Communications Director, covered the scope and purpose of the MYAC, detailing some of Mayor Bristol's expectations but also encouraging the students to take an active role in leading and conducting their meetings as well as sharing their ideas.

7. Election of MYAC Chair and Vice-Chair – Todd Rice, Communications Director (TR)

Mr. Rice asked past council members to better explain the roles of Chair and Vice Chair. Mr. He, the past MYAC Chair, detailed his responsibilities. The Council agreed to vote on the positions at the next meeting with those interested bringing a pitch for why they would like the position to the October meeting.

8. Requests for Future Agenda Items – Myrisa Petty, Community Engagement Coordinator (MP)
