The meeting was called to order at 6:42 pm by President Sylvia Gomez.

Present were President Sylvia Gomez, Vice President Bethany James, Secretary/ Treasurer Sherry Quartermous, Board Member Darwin Brown, Associa Manager Marca Ray, and Lee Harriss of the City of Grand Prairie. Absent was board member Mary Gray. There were 3 additional homeowners present.

- 1. The minutes of the July 6, 2023, were not available for approval at the time of the meeting.
- 2. The board President Sylvia Gomez opened with introductions.
- 3. Officer Jim West with the Grand Prairie Police Department presented a presentation on the functions of the Police Department and Crime prevention. Mr. West explained how Monterrey Park PID can set up a Crime watch with 51% participation within the community. Mr. West also explained the benefits of the Flock Camera system and how the community can all work together to be a safer place.
