SUMMARY

The Committee will host a Community Input Meeting, with plan to apply for Round 5 Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program

DISCUSSION

Melton Design Group is asking the community for input on protentional levee concept plan for upcoming Statewide Grant funding program. This competitive grant program creates new parks and new recreation opportunities in the underserved communities across California.

Round 5 applications will be due by late spring or early summer 2023. Staff will monitor California State Parks webpage for specific date announcements. Once the application deadline is announced, five months will be given before applications are due.

In partnership with Melton Design Group, the City of Oroville received Round 4 funding for Hewitt Park, Phase II we anticipate the completion of this large project by 2024. More information about Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program can be found www.parks.ca.gov
