 - o Attorney Evashevski informed the Council that most of Mr. Murray's concerns were addressed by Adam Young at the October 8th Planning Commission meeting
 - o Mr. Murray requested a special meeting with the Master Plan Committee to further discuss his concerns with the draft master plan
 - Special meeting has been set to Tuesday, October 22, 2024 at 10:00 am

- Email from Kevin Doyle regarding the use of Manor V property, formerly lot 10, by O'Boyle & Co. for materials storage during the Forest Way duplex construction
 - o Dennis Dombroski informed the Council that he had referred Mr. Doyle's letter to Sean O'Boyle and they have added the Pulte Foundation to O'Boyle's insurance. Sounds like Pulte Foundation is satisfied
 - o Mr. Dombroski further noted that he has confirmation from the Pulte Foundation that what has been done by O'Boyle is satisfactory and he will get that to the Clerk for the file

Motion made by Moskwa, seconded by Corrigan, to send Pulte Foundation a formal request for the use of their property, formerly known as Manor V lot 10, for the storage of materials during the construction of the Forest Way Duplexes, assuring them that the property will be restored to its original condition at the end of the project, and thanking them in advance for the use of the property.

- o Kyle O'Boyle of O'Boyle & Co. informed the Council that he has been in contact with Mark Pulte and Kevin Doyle in the last few days regarding this. Will send communications to the Clerk for the file.

 - o Councilman Moskwa inquired if the lot split should be approved prior to the approval of these vehicle permits
 - Attorney Evashevski responded that the Council can approve the vehicle permits contingent upon the lot split being approved and the paperwork being completed for the withdraw of the special land use which had been granted to the previous property owner
 - o Vehicles will arrive the week of November 4th and will be in use for one (1) week.

 - o Dennis Dombroski voiced concerns regarding the City's liability – holding the City liable if an Otis worker was injured during testing
 - o Page 6, paragraph 11 has language regarding the “sole negligence” of Otis
 - Attorney Evashevski spoke with an Otis rep and they are willing to remove the word “sole” before negligence
 - Attorney Evashevski instructed that, whoever signs the agreements should cross out the word “sole” and initial the page, and she will follow up with Otis on that part of the agreement.

Motion made by Moskwa, Seconded by Chambers, to accept all three (3) agreements with Attorney Evashevski's suggestion to strike the word “sole” on page 6, paragraph 11 of each agreement.

- Winter Service Agreement Deviation
 - o Shepler's will be running their fleet under the Mackinac Island Ferry Company (MIFC) Winter Service Agreement.
 - o Amendments that were agreed to at the last meeting have been added
 - o Arnold Transit Co. will step in to winter service after December 1st
 - o Would like to further add the Hope under Shepler's assets and Isle Royal Queen III under Sip n' Sale's assets to the Winter Service Agreement
 - o If Arnold is not ready by Dec. 1st, Shepler's is willing to stay on as long as they can, weather permitting
 - o Arnold's Ottawa - many repairs being done but working hard to get it ready for winter service
 - (2) weeks out on the generator, which has to be installed before the engines can go in
 - o Arnold's Huron - started blasting the decks – Coast Guard is checking in regularly
 - o Councilwoman Myers requested that the updated schedule be posted as soon as possible
 - Many concerns with the red line for Sunday service - maybe it should read "No first boat on Sundays" to be a bit more clear

Motion made by Sehoyan, Seconded by Moskwa, to approve the Winter Service Agreement Deviation Amendment with the discussed changes and additions.

 - The Police Department and State Park had a meeting regarding the speed limit signs and the State Park is working on getting them made and placed

- Maintenance Department to purchase a new Poly Wafer kit (power broom) for John Deere tractors to perform street cleaning

- Authorization to distribute the draft Master Plan for review in accordance with the Michigan Planning Enabling Act
 - To distribute to the draft Master Plan to the surrounding communities, county, and other specified entities for review. These entities will then have 63 days to provide comment back to the City in writing
 - Changes can be made to the Master Plan up until the time of adoption
 - The Master Plan Committee will meet again before the Master Plan is adopted
 - Councilman Moskwa inquired if there are any objections to proposed changes, how is that to be resolved?
 - After the comment period, the draft plan has to go back through both the Planning Commission and the City Council, which have to concur on the implementation of the changes
 - Approval today is simply to send the draft out for comment
 - Attorney Evashevski will look in to the exact procedures for this
 Motion made by Corrigan, Seconded by Chambers, to distribute the draft master plan to surrounding communities, county, and other specified entities for review in accordance with the Michigan Planning Enabling Act.

 - Councilman Moskwa would prefer to table for (2) weeks until after the Master Plan Committee meeting on October 22nd

 - o Mayor Doud has discussed this with Chris and feels that it is a health, safety, welfare issue
 - o Maybe consider approving with the caveat that if Shepler’s is not providing winter service, then they cannot have the curtains

TO ADOPT THE ANNUAL EXEMPTION OPTION AS SET FORTH IN 2011 PUBLIC ACT 152, THE PUBLICLY FUNDED HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRIBUTION ACT

WHEREAS, 2011 Public Act 152 (the “Act”) was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on September 24, 2011;

WHEREAS, the Act contains three options for complying with the requirements of the Act;

WHEREAS, the three options are as follows:

- 1) Section 3 - “Hard Caps” Option - limits a public employer’s total annual health care costs for employees based on coverage levels, as defined in the Act;
- 2) Section 4 - “80%/20%” Option - limits a public employer’s share of total annual health care costs to not more than 80%. This option requires an annual majority vote of the governing body;
- 3) Section 8 - “Exemption” Option - a local unit of government, as defined in the Act, may exempt itself from the requirements of the Act by an annual 2/3 vote of the governing body;

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to adopt the annual Exemption option as its choice of compliance under the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by such Action occurring on Wednesday, October 30, 2024 the City Council of the City of Mackinac Island elects to comply with the requirements of 2011 Public Act 152, the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, by adopting the annual Exemption option for the medical benefit plan coverage year January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

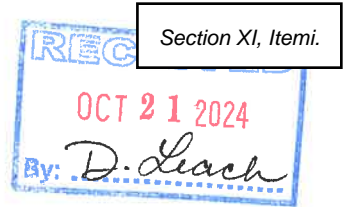



