4. CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

- ➤ The following is a memo, in its entirety, from Interim City Manager Weaver:
- Port Commission Select Committee on Policies, Procedures, Rates, and Fees
 The Committee members Raymond Bulter, Larry Nichols, Jamie O'Neal, Jim Rudellat and Jody Weaver met on Tuesday, April 9th. Harbor Master Jim Rudellat is gathering policy and procedure information from other ports, particularly Calhoun County and Victoria and the committee will meet again prior to the next Port Commission Regular meeting in May.
- Port Commission recommendation to Council regarding Budgetary and Financial management policies.

The City Council adopted a new Budgetary & Financial policy for the FYE 2025 Fiscal year which includes the following language:

Ports and Harbors Fund

It will be the general policy of the City that the fees collected will be spent on maintenance and capital improvements of the Ports and Harbors Fund facilities, grounds, and other structures. Annually, an amount equal to the sum of all property taxes collected from Port Commission leased properties shall be transferred from the General Fund to the Ports and Harbors Fund for which sum will be spent on maintenance and capital improvements of the Port facilities, grounds, and other structures. No other general fund tax dollars will be used for this purpose, except as a loan from the General Fund to the Ports and Harbors Fund, approved by Council.

• TPWL Grant — Renovations to the Nautical Landings Marina Breakwater

TPWL did hear back from USFWS with conditional approval of the bid documents. It is now with the TPWD Wildlife Habitat Assessment (WHAB) which takes approximately 45 days to complete and then is sent back to USFWS for final approval. Kateryna Thomas, our Capital Improvement Projects and Grants Coordinator is working on applying for an extension.

• CDBG-MIT Coastal Resilience Living Shoreline Project

The Joint Evaluation meeting with the various State and Federal agencies was held on April 10 and Mott McDonald is still on track with submitting the application next week. Mott McDonald

is working to address the comments made which included NMFS requested fish gaps in the breakwater, TPWL is asking for a 2:1 mitigation for the oysters; GLO wants a coastal boundary survey; and USFWS asked if we were planning any mitigation efforts to account for any mercury in the sediment.

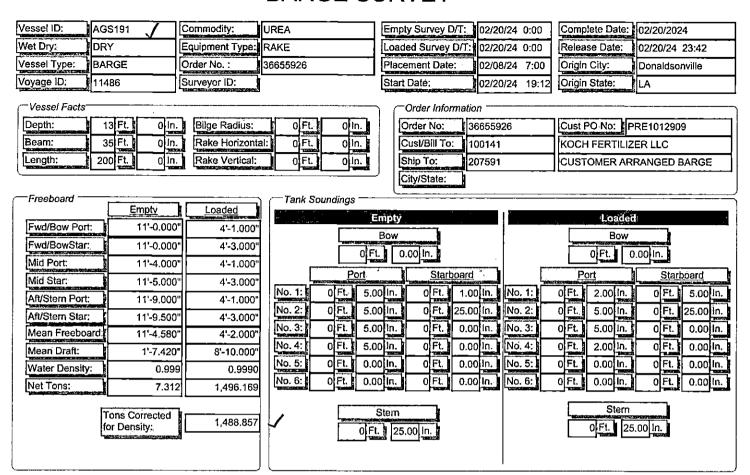

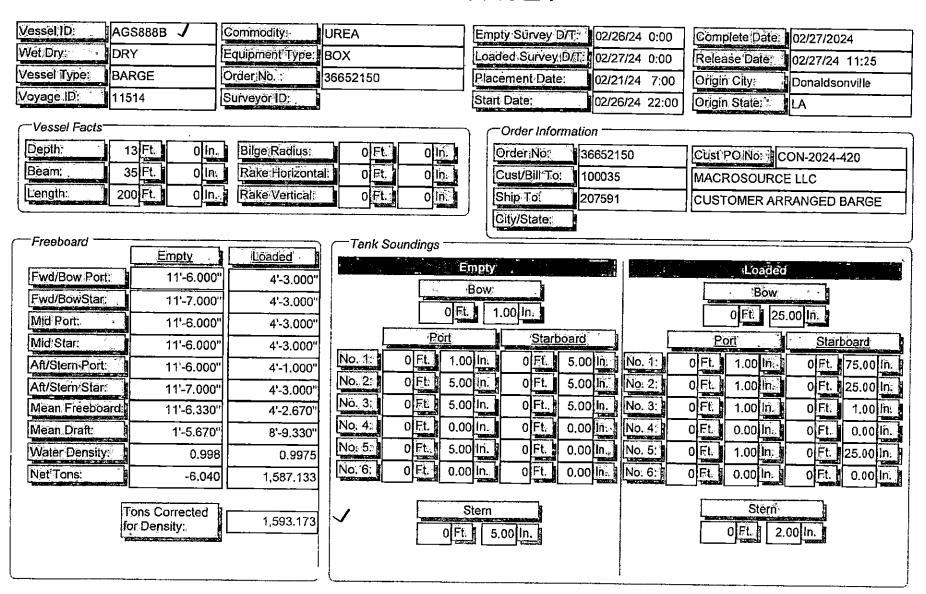

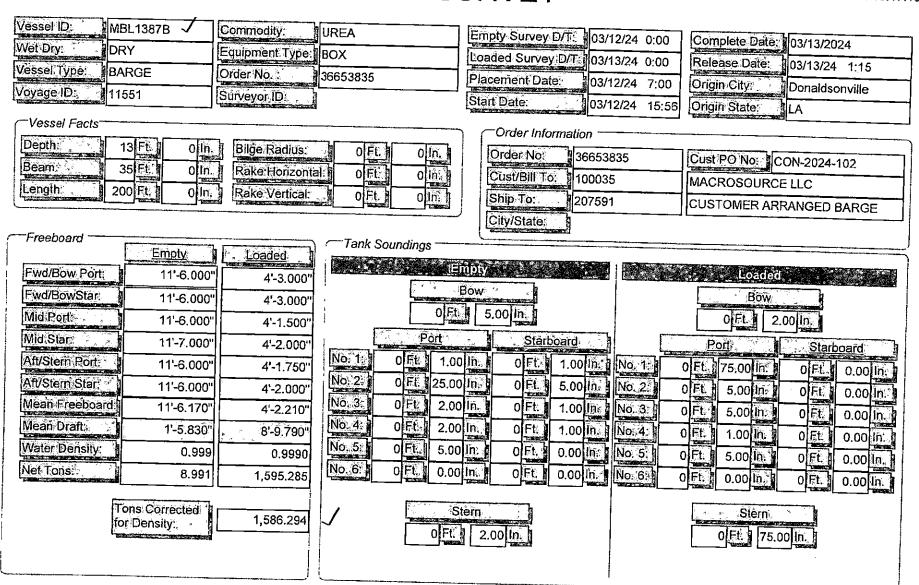

• TPWL Grant – Renovations to the Nautical Landings Marina Breakwater The project has been approved by the TPWD Wildlife Habitat Assessment (WHAB) and was sent back to USFWS for final approval. Kateryna Thomas, our Capital Improvement Projects and Grants Coordinator prepared and received approval of an 18-mo extension for this grant.

I have reached out to both Congressman Cloud's office and Sen. Cornyn's office asking for help to expedite this federal approval. They have both responded and are looking into the issue.

CDBG-MIT Coastal Resilience Living Shoreline Project

Mott McDonald has submitted the USCOE permit application. Raymond Butler, Jim Rudellat and I met with the engineers on Friday to discuss options with regard to the NMFS request for fish gaps. We agreed that at least one fish gap would not be a bad idea. Although NMFS has requested gaps every 500 ft (which would require 3 gaps), we believe we can provide one protected gap and stay close to budget. Mott McDonald is preparing a response report to submit to USCOE and we'll see where that goes. To comply fully with the NMFS request, would require us to reduce the height of the breakwater to bring the cost within budget.

SECTION 1 – GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES & REGULATIONS

DESCRIPTION & JURISDICTION OF PORT COMMISSION

Mariners are to consult appropriate authorities and information sources when determining constraints upon navigation in and around the Harbor of Refuge, Smith Harbor, Nautical Landings Marina, and City Harbor and not rely upon information contained herein for the purpose of safe navigation.

All properties now or subsequently owned by the City which are designated port, wharf and dock property or waters shall hereafter be placed under the supervision and control of the City Council. In order to provide a forum for public regarding such properties, a Port Commission has been created by ordinance by Council, to consist of not less than five (5) nor more than seven (7) members. Said Commissioners shall be qualified voters of the City, shall be over twenty-five (25) years of age, shall not be members of the Council, and shall be appointed to serve without compensation for a period of two (2) years, by a majority vote of the Council. Commissioners may be removed by a majority vote of the Council with or without cause.

The Port Commission shall provide recommendations to the City Manager regarding said port, wharf and dock properties and waters, and is expressly empowered to:

- (a) Appoint its own Chair and Secretary and adopt its own rules and order of business. It shall keep minutes of its meetings and the minutes shall be open to public inspection. Its meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings laws.
- (b) Provide recommendations regarding the extension and improvement of the physical properties to facilitate the most efficient operation of the port and for the best interest of the inhabitants of the City.
- (c) Make recommendations to the Council for ordinances to provide for the issuance of licenses and/or permits and to adopt such rules and regulations it deems necessary for the operation of the port, as well as for the use of port property, so long as the same are not inconsistent with the general laws and administrative rules relative thereto.
- (d) Review and provide recommendations to the Council on the budget for port operations each year at the regular budget time for the City.
