The City of Tybee Island proposes to use FY 2018 and FY 2019 LMIG funds to resurface multiple streets. The streets planned for resurfacing are 5<sup>th</sup> St from Butler Ave to Jones Ave, Lovell Ave from 7<sup>th</sup> St to 9<sup>th</sup> St, 17<sup>th</sup> St from Butler Ave to Jones Ave, Old Hwy 80 from Hwy 80 to end, and Inlet Ave from Hwy 80 to Chatham Ave. Each street will receive a 1 ½" overlay with the exception of Old Hwy 80, which will require 3". Cumulatively, this list will consist of 0.86 miles of resurfaced streets for the City of Tybee Island.

The FY 2018 disbursement was deferred to be used in conjunction with the anticipated FY 2019 disbursement. This will allow the City to receive a potentially improved bid price due to the increased amount of roads to be resurfaced.
