SUBJECT: Cooper City High School Water Polo Team Recognition. – Commissioner Mallozzi

BACKGROUND OF ITEM:

Named as the Sun Sentinel and Miami Herald's Water Polo Player of the Year and First Team for Broward County:

Matthew Troche - Matthew has been playing water polo for the past seven years and is a Junior at CCHS. He was the lone Olympic Development Program Youth National team selection from South Florida and led the Cowboys to the regional semi-finals. He finished with 78 goals, 64 assists, 72 steals, and 39 exclusions drawn. Matt has since become one of the state's most well-rounded players and hopes to carry that talent to the college level.

Named as Sun Sentinel's Water Polo First Team for Broward County:

Skylar Flowers – Skylar has been playing water polo for three years and is a Freshman at CCHS. She has led the Cowboys in goals, assists, and steals in her first season playing high school. She has played in the Junior Olympics in Dallas, being named 2023 JO All-American 16U, and has played for the Southeast Zone Olympic Development Team in California. The Cowboys are excited to see Skylar develop throughout her high school career.

Carleigh Schleicher - Carleigh is a four-year varsity water polo player and a Senior at CCHS. She has received the Coaches Award, MVP, and Team Co-Captain. She is a certified Lifeguard, CPR, AED, and Water Safety Instructor. She has been an accomplished competitive swimmer since the age of 5 and will be attending FAU, where we hope she continues to play water polo.

Cooper City Boys Water Polo Team

The CCHS Boys Water Polo team returned this season to win Districts for the third year in a row, continuing the furthest in the State Series, losing to St Thomas in the Regional Semifinals. They finished with a 12-11 season attending tournaments with the help of donations from team families and the American Legion. We had five boys named to the Miami Herald All Broward Water Polo Teams and can't wait to see what next season brings.
