Discussed action to authorize the purchase of approximately 1,246 stream credits for an estimated price of \$99,680 for the Harmony Grove Church Road Extension Project. Funding will be allocated from SPLOST funds. Located in Post 1. George Jones, Transportation Director stated that Harmony Grove Church Road is an undivided roadway. The end of the roadway serves as a private driveway. In order to provide additional connectivity to an under construction County Middle School located adjacent to Seven Hill Connector, a new tow lane roadway is under design. He further stated that while under design, a stream has been identified and will be impacted. Because of the impact to this stream, the County is required to purchase stream credits. Available streambank credits are becoming hard to find but some have been located in the Oostanaula River Wetland and Steam Mitigation Bank.

Commissioner Galloway asked Mr. Jones if this was a Federal Requirement.

Mr. Jones stated yes, the Clean Water Act requires it. When you disturb a stream, you have to buy credits to protect another location.

Ray Wooten, Water System Director stated that in order to provided redundancy at the Rakestraw Pump Station on the east side of the City of Hiram, off of Poplar Springs Road, the County began working with Brennan Jones Engineering Associates, LLC to reroute 40 percent of the sanitary sewer flow to the Cadillac Pump Station. This project requires three phases of work.
