City Manager, Joseph R. Pace, declared a meeting of the City Council Parks and Recreation Committee duly open for the transaction of business at 5:30 p.m.

The second item on the agenda was to review and consider Ordinance: An ordinance amending the City of Wharton Code of Ordinances, Chapter 42, Occupational Licenses, Taxes and Regulations, Article IV, Division 4 Mobile Food Courts and Mobile Food Establishments, Sections 42-220 to 42-235; providing that a violation of the ordinance or any part of the code as adopted hereby shall constitute a penalty upon conviction of a fine; providing for separability and setting an effective date. Assistant to the Building Official, Claudia Velasquez, presented to the Committee the amendments/additions to the City of Wharton Code of Ordinances, Chapter 42, Occupational Licenses, Taxes and Regulations, Article IV, Division 4, Mobile Food Courts and Mobile Food Establishments, Section 42-220 to Section 42-235. After some discussion, Councilmember, Russell Machann, made a motion to recommend to the City Council to approve the amendments/additions to the City of Wharton Code of Ordinances, Chapter 42, Occupational Licenses, Taxes and

Regulations, Article IV, Division 4, Mobile Food Courts and Mobile Food Establishments, Section 42-220 to Section 42-235. Councilmember, Steven Schneider, seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
