Congratulations to the Vermilion Coastal Committee on hosting a successful Vermilion Parish Coastal Day on Tuesday, August 6, 2019. I personally want to thank the Committee for their Coastal Restoration efforts.

The Mayor, council and I attended a Coastal Restoration meeting on Wednesday, August 14. This meeting was an overview of current past and upcoming projects. These projects include barrier reef construction, marsh fill-in and levee restorations. I have invited Mr. Ralph Libersat to give a short summary of his presentation at our next council meeting.

During last week's meeting, a group of Lafayette Volunteers gave an informative, comprehensive presentation on regional watershed and identified potential projects that could help mitigate flooding. Upon these projects was the issue of dredging the Vermilion River.

Tonight, Lafayette's City-Parish Council is considering a resolution that declares "the urgent need to dredge the Vermilion River to prevent future flooding" and calls on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to help the city-parish government obtain the necessary permit. They are also considering appropriating \$5 million to start the project.

I am bringing this to the attention of the Council tonight to make sure we do our part to protect the Citizens of Abbeville and all of Vermilion Parish.

I want to make it clear; I am not against dredging. I am not against Lafayette. This is not a Lafayette versus Abbeville issue. This is a regional issue. We empathize with the issues Lafayette Parish is facing because we have the same issues in The City of Abbeville.

We have had the opportunity to participate in calls and meetings with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and we appreciate that consideration. I want to ask the Corps to continue to look at watershed as an entire region and not rush to action in one area before understanding the effects those actions might have. I am asking the Corps of Engineers to do no harm. We want time to review a complete study and modeling on the effects of dredging the Vermilion River prior to moving forward and we want to make sure modeling takes into consideration tides, narrowing of rivers due to bridge structures and is inclusive of effects of wind. What effect does an increase in the volume of water in any one area have on areas downstream? We want to continue to be part of the conversation.

This issue effects our entire Parish. I encourage all municipalities to voice their concerns. I encourage citizens to let their Representatives, Congressmen and Senators hear their concerns over rushing a project before we know what, if any, harmful effects it might have.

# RESOLUTION NO.: R-19-\_\_\_

**BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED**, that pursuant to a public notice, a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Abbeville was held on the 20th day of August, 2019, commencing at 5:30 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Abbeville, Louisiana, where the following resolution was moved, duly seconded, passed and adopted, to-wit:

WHERE AS, the Lafayette City-Parish Council will adopt Resolution No. R047-2019 at its August 20, 2019 meeting proposing to create an urgent need for the dredging of the Vermilion River: thereby seeking assistance from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in the permit process; seeking funding from both State of Louisiana and Federal sources; and asking that Tech-Vermilion Fresh Water District cease the pumping of water from any source into the Vermilion River; and

WHERE AS, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, and others are conducting drainage studies to determine the effects future dredging will, or may, have on residential and business property owners in Abbeville, Louisiana;

WHERE AS, said drainage studies have not yet been completed; therefore, the impact of dredging in Lafayette Parish upon the City of Abbeville, its residents, and property owners cannot be quantified;

WHERE AS, irreparable harm could be done to the City of Abbeville, its residents, and property owners by the premature dredging of the Vermilion River in Lafayette Parish without the benefit of the studies.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Abbeville, acting as the governing authority of said city does hereby request that the U.S Army Corps of Engineers delay the issuance of any and all permits to the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated government unless, and until all pertinent drainage studies are completed, and then issued only to the extent that it can be ascertained that no damage will be done to the City of Abbeville, its residents, and property owners as a result of the permitted dredging.
