City of Abbeville Committee Meeting October 17, 2023

The Mayor and Council of the City of Abbeville met for a committee meeting on October 17, 2023 at 5:20 P.M., at the regular meeting place, the Council Meeting Room located at 101 North State Street, Abbeville, Louisiana, with the Honorable Roslyn R. White, Mayor, presiding.

Mayor White stated that we are here for a Finance Committee meeting chaired by Councilman Francis Touchet, Jr. She asked if there were any comments from the public on any agenda item. There were none.

She turned the floor over to Councilman Touchet. He stated that the only agenda item is an update of the budget expenses and revenues after the  $3^{rd}$  quarter of 2023. He asked Mr. Steve Moosa to provide the update.

*Mr.* Moosa distributed spreadsheets comparing the revenue 2022 actual and 2023 actual and budgeted for the first nine months of each year. Sales tax collected in 2023 is slightly ahead of what was collected in 2022. Both water and sewer revenues were higher than last year at this time and both were ahead of budget. Electrical revenue is ahead of budget by 7%. All revenues are ahead of budget of the prior year. The second spreadsheet compared payroll for each department. The general fund budget is ahead of budget and the Utility System Fund is overbudget by 2%. The third spreadsheet compared expenses of all departments. The only department that is currently overbudget is the Water Department. There have been several necessary repairs at the Water Treatment Plant due to the freeze in late December and issues with the clarifier and valves and other ongoing maintenance. These are one-time expenses and the City can absorb those costs.

Mayor White asked if there were any comments from the public on any agenda item prior to action. There were none.

Dr. Erick Knezek, a candidate for BESE District 7, discussed his qualifications for the position and plans for the office if he is elected

Mrs. Kristen Moore discussed the Pathways Forward and College Tour program through the Nehemiah Project.

Mayor White asked again if there were any comments from the public on any agenda item since the amendment to the agenda occurred after the original request for public comments. There were no comments.

- She has drafted a letter to be given to landlords for eviction proceedings. The letter is to inform them of the City's implementation of a comprehensive plan to regulate and to eliminate litter and roadside debris as much as possible. She has forwarded the draft to the City Court Judge for his review and approval. The letter will be posted online after his approval and she will share it with the Police Jury.
- Discussed the events of the upcoming Louisiana Cattle Festival that is scheduled for this weekend.
- There were a lot of crime issues over the weekend. Some arrests have been made and the Police Department is still working on the rest. Councilman Touchet and Councilman Broussard asked Lieutenant Hardy to ask Chief Hardy to get all agencies involved. Mayor White agreed that we need to use every resource available.

# Councilman Brady Broussard, Jr.

- Asked Lieutenant Hardy for additional patrols to monitor night walkers due to the increase in vandalism. Councilman Campbell stated that we do have crime but you can't restrict people's liberties.

# Councilwoman Terry Broussard

- She asked everyone to get involved with Vermilion Reach on Facebook for the upcoming Martin Luther King, Jr. Day activities.

- The NAACP Banquet is scheduled for October 21, 2023.

Mayor White called the meeting to order and requested a roll call. Mayor White led those assembled in prayer. Mayor White asked Councilman Brady Broussard, Jr. to lead the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor White asked if there were any comments from the public on any agenda item prior to action. There were none.

Councilwoman Broussard had requested that representatives from Envolve Community, Live Oak Manor, attend the meeting to address concerns over crime at Live Oak Manor and to discuss possible solutions. Ms. Vonn Williams and Mr. Smart attended the meeting. The on-site manager of Live Oak Manor was also in attendance at the meeting. Councilwoman Broussard stated that people are living in fear at Live Oak Manor and something needs to be done regarding the crime. Mayor White stated that there have been ongoing issues on and around the property so she set up a conference call to get the crime there under control. They are needing a permit to fix four units and she refuses to sign off on the permit until we feel like we can put people in safe spaces. Mr. Smart stated that he is the director of security for Envolve and oversees 100 properties. He resides in Georgia. They have 32 cameras, security and camera monitoring. They screen their applicants but they cannot screen those who they invite. They have a master list of those not allowed on the property. If they are found on the property, the tenant is evicted. They are now providing that list to the Abbeville Police Department. Ms. Lauren Trahan stated that the low-income housing is in disrepair and she is concerned about the standard of living there. Ms. Marshetta stated that they do inspections. It is the responsibility of the tenant to keep their bathroom clean so that mold does not grow. Ms. Williams stated that the complex was last renovated ten years ago and it will be eligible for a renovation in five years. Mayor White stated that we do have a need for low-income housing and the complex

profits off of the low-income individuals so we need to hold the complex to a higher standard. Stewart Head told the representatives that they need an electrical upgrade now. They could not open the disconnect box when there was a fire. This is a fire hazard. Councilman Campbell is concerned about the personal items being dumped onto the street. Councilwoman Broussard stated that the on-premises security guards should not become friends with the tenants. Councilman Touchet stated that Mayor should not issue the building permit until there are changes. This is about quality of life. Mayor White stated that she will have to see significant progress before she agrees to issue the permit but will continue to work with them to see this through.

-03 introduced by Mr. Carlton Campbell and seconded by Ms. Terry Broussard to approve the street name change of Handy Street to Ruffin Drive. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Chris Gautreaux stated that the pilings have been delivered to LaFitte Drive-In Park for the upcoming pier and wharf project. They will be closing the dog park and fishing pond most likely within one week for the work to begin. The walking trail will remain open as long as it is safe. We will post the language about the closing on the sign and social media.

-08 introduced by Mr. Brady Broussard, Jr. and seconded by Ms. Terry Broussard to authorize the Mayor to execute the Fiscal Agency Agreement with Bank of Abbeville and Gulf Coast Bank effective October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2025. The motion carried unanimously.

-09 introduced by Mr. Brady Broussard, Jr. and seconded by Mr. Francis Touchet, Jr. to grant a variance for the freestanding sign for Chloe Rose' located at 232 S. Main Street. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor White discussed the popup parklet and walkability demonstrations in downtown Abbeville. The Louisiana Department of Health and Hospital have granted the City of Abbeville *\$10,000 to move the initiative forward. We will be putting things in place as a demonstration* prior to them becoming permanent. One of the ideas we are throwing around is choking Highway 82 down to one lane when you get to the split instead of two lanes. We are also considering a four-way stop or a mini roundabout in the intersection. We will observe behavior of drivers and pedestrians, then put a demonstration, observe what it does to speed and walkability and then get feedback from the community. We would then take all these things into consideration before we design the final project. We will also look at safety crossing for the people who work at the courthouse who park in the shelled parking lot on the southeast side. We will do a popup demonstration there to make the intersection safer. We will get feedback and then decide how we will finalize that design. The idea is to see how we can use our streets better for cars, bikers and walkers. Once we implement the demonstrations downtown, we can use them in other areas. The last one is the popup parklet that will be at Tito's. This will allow people to dine outside as a temporary structure. We would be able to see how it affects the business and we could also get feedback from the customers. It will be modular in design so we can use it again.

# Chris Gautreaux, Public Works Director

- Discussed the various projects the Public Works Department are working on. The gas company bored into our sewer line but it was repaired today. The Street Department is preparing for upcoming VC Homecoming parade and the Omelette Celebration. The Cattle Festival went very well.

# Mayor Roslyn White

- Gave the Parks and Recreation Coordinator report since Byron and Kristin could not be here tonight.
- She reminded everyone that the Vermilion Reach Group is having a cleanup day on October 28, 2023 beginning at 8:00 AM.

# Mike Hardy, Police Chief

- The overtime earned by the Police Department for the Cattle Festival is \$16,702.00. Mayor White added that the overtime for the City crews is about \$4,000.00.
- Councilman Touchet asked if Stonebridge is in compliance. Chief Hardy stated they are not. Councilman Touchet stated that we have to hold them accountable and we need to find some teeth to get them in compliance.

# Jude Mire, Fire Chief

- They are beginning to paint the fire hydrants.

Councilwoman Terry Broussard

- The NAACP banquet will be held Saturday at the American Legion. The tickets are \$25.00 in advance or \$30.00 at the door.

Councilman Brady Broussard, Jr.

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# City of Abbeville Vehicle Use Policy

- 1. Only City employees, possessing a valid State of Louisiana driver's license appropriate for the vehicle, are authorized to operate City vehicles.
- 2. All City employees must immediately notify their Department Head any time their license is denied, suspended or revoked, or any other administrative proceeding with the division or agency that regulates driving records.
- 3. Employees shall not operate a City vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 4. Employees shall not transport any persons other than City employees in a City vehicle, except in the course of official business.
- 5. Employees and authorized passengers are expected to observe all traffic regulations, including seatbelt usage, and all policies and procedures of the City, while operating the vehicle.
- 6. All incidents involving City vehicles must be reported to the law enforcement office of the appropriate jurisdiction, the employee's supervisor, and to Risk Management immediately. Employees with City vehicles will provide copies of any accident reports, citations, etc., concerning the vehicle or its operation, to the supervisor and/or Risk Management.
- 7. Employees will not operate the vehicles in such a way as to cause public criticism or nuisance. This includes vehicle parking when not in use.
- 8. Employees are expressly prohibited from making any cosmetic or mechanical modifications to any City owned vehicle without approval.
- 9. City vehicles may only be used for conducting City business and **may not** be used for personal or private use.
- 10. Unattended City vehicles shall be legally parked and locked at all times, except in emergency circumstances. Employees shall not leave sensitive information or public documents (other than reference material) in the vehicle while off duty.
- 11. City vehicle emblems must be easily identifiable while employees are conducting City business.
- 12. Employees are responsible for the maintenance of the City vehicles. **City vehicles must be kept clean and truck beds must remain free from debris which may fly out and liter property.** Scheduled maintenance will be coordinated with the Supervisor/Department Head. Employees may be subject to disciplinary action for failing to maintain the vehicle in proper working order or if there are signs of mechanical abuse or uncleanliness.

- 13. City vehicles are equipped with GPS devices. Employees may be subject to disciplinary action for tampering with GPS devices.
- 14. The use of cell phones (including texting, reading, and sending messages) while behind the wheel of a moving vehicle being used by City employees is strictly prohibited.
- 15. Smoking is prohibited in City vehicles.

#### **RULE VII**

### ANNUAL AND OTHER LEAVES OF ABSENCE

#### Section 2 Sick Leave

- 2.1 All employees in the classified service shall receive one day of sick leave for each calendar month of service up to a maximum of 180 days.
- 2.2 Repealed.
- 2.3 An employee who has taken sick leave shall file with his Department Head a certificate stating the cause of his absence and the amount of leave taken. If the amount of leave taken is in excess of two (2) consecutive days, a registered physician must certify to the nature of the illness or injury and the necessity for absence. If there is a reasonable doubt as to the validity of an employee's claim for consecutive sick leave of two (2) days or less, the Department Head and/or the Appointing Authority may require other acceptable proof that the employee was ill and unable to report to work. When it has been determined that an employee has charged an absence against sick leave, although no actual sickness occurred, the value of absent time must be deducted from the employee's annual leave or if earned annual leave is insufficient, deduction shall be made from employee's pay. In addition, disciplinary action may be taken by the appointing authority.
- 2.4 Workmen's Compensation Insurance payments: If and when the disability of an employee is of a nature that he is entitled to payments under any Workmen's Compensation Insurance which is effective, he shall at his option, be entitled to receive sick leave with pay to the extent that sick leave has accumulated, provided that the City of Abbeville is reimbursed in an amount equivalent to that received by the employee as Workmen's Compensation Insurance while he is on sick leave with pay. It shall be the duty of the employee to reimburse the City of Abbeville payments for sick leave in an amount equivalent to that received as Workmen's Compensation for each day during which payments for sick leave and Workmen's Compensation are both received. After all accumulated sick leave has been used, the employee shall be entitled to Workmen's Compensation only.
- 2.5 On December 31st of each year the unused accumulated sick leave earned by an employee shall be carried forward to the succeeding year, subject to the cap established in Section 2.1, above.
- 2.6 In the event an employee is terminated for cause or voluntarily terminates employment without the benefit of retirement, all rights to compensation for unused sick leave will be forfeited. In the event the employee retires from the retirement system with the required years of service, all accumulated sick leave will be applied to the employee's service year accumulation in the retirement system as may be allowed by law.

Provided, however, that employees voluntarily terminating their employment with the City of Abbeville and being re-employed shall have their sick leave reinstated as follows:

- (a) Re-employment within three months of voluntary termination 100% of sick leave reinstated.
- (b) Re-employment within six months of voluntary termination—75% of sick leave reinstated.
- (c) Re-employment within nine months of voluntary termination 50% of sick leave reinstated.
- (d) Re-employment within twelve months of voluntary termination 25% of sick leave reinstated.

Any employee re-employed after one year has lapsed since his voluntary termination of employment with the City of Abbeville shall not be entitled to reinstatement of any accumulated sick leave.

- 2.7 Employees on authorized leave of absence without pay shall not earn sick leave during the period of their leave of absence but shall retain all accumulated sick leave up to the time their leave commences.
- 2.8 Transfers, promotion or demotions shall in no way affect the status of earned sick leave.
- 2.9 In computing charges against accrued sick leave, deduction shall be made only for work days. If employee is reimbursing city with workmen's compensation check, charges of one-half day for each work day shall be made to the employee's accrued sick leave.
- 2.10 Employees who have used up all accumulated sick leave and annual leave and have not been granted extended leave without pay under Section 4 of this rule shall be automatically terminated and placed on the appropriate reemployment list. Employees automatically terminated and seeking reemployment will be required to complete a physical and a drug screen prior to being placed on the rehire list. Any employee rehired from such re-employment list shall be assigned the step classification to which he was assigned upon termination. Any employee so rehired shall have annual leave benefits calculated based upon his original employment date less that time in which leave of absence without pay was exercised and less that time between termination and re-employment

# Statements to be Considered to Include in the Present Handbook

### RULE VII ANNUAL AND OTHER LEAVES OF ABSENCE

### Section 4 Leave of Absence Without Pay

4.1 The appointing authority may, upon written request of an employee and with the approval of the Director, grant a leave of absence without pay in accordance with the schedule below during a period of twelve (12) consecutive months whenever it is determined to be in the best interest of the city.

Leave without pay is a temporary, non-pay status and absence from duty, granted by the Appointing Authority and with the approval of the Director of Personnel, upon an employee's written request.

Continuous Service	Maximum Leave Allowed
Less than six months	30 calendar days
More and six months but less than one year	90 calendar days
Over one year but less than two years	145 calendar days
Over two years but less than three years	200 calendar days
Over three years but less than four years	255 calendar days
Over four years but less than five years	310 calendar days
Over five years	365 calendar days

- The employee does not earn holiday pay, annual leave, or sick leave during a pay period while on leave without pay.
- The employee does not contribute to the retirement system; therefore, he does not earn service credit toward retirement while on leave without pay. Credit service accumulates once the employee returns to work and contributes to the retirement system.
- All leaves of absence without pay requested and granted shall not exceed a period of one (1) year.

4.2 All leaves of absence without pay shall be granted only after all accumulated sick leave (if applicable) and annual leave in excess of one-third (1/3) of each applicable leave balance at the onset of the illness, injury, or necessity for absence has been exhausted.

4.3 Requests for leave of absence without pay may be granted for periods not to exceed thirty (30) consecutive calendar days. Thereafter, all extensions of such leave may be granted in increments not to exceed thirty (30) calendar days.

4.4 All requests for leave without pay for illness or injury in excess of two consecutive days must include a statement from a registered physician that the employee is unable to perform his duties and must indicate the approximate length of time that he will be incapacitated.

4.5 Employees shall be provided written confirmation, including starting and ending dates of all leaves of absence granted by the appointing authority. When an employee does not return to work at the

expiration of the period of leave without pay authorized here in, he shall be automatically considered having abandoned the position and having constructively tendered a resignation.

4.6. An authorized leave of absence without pay may be curtailed by the appointing authority when it is determined to be in the best interest of the city and written notice thereof is furnished to the employee ten (10) calendar days in advance.

4.7 An employee on leave of absence without pay may return to work with the approval of the Appointing Authority and the Director of Personnel, prior to the expiration of leave authorized, provided:

(1) A written request to return to work is made to the Director of Personnel and the Appointing Authority five (5) business days prior to the requested return to work date.

(2) Requests to return to work from the absences granted for illness or injury must include a statement from all treating physicians that the employee is capable of performing the duties of his classification without restriction.

Employees shall be provided confirmation of requests to amend leave of absence authorized prior to the expected return to work date.

When an employee does not return to work on the date requested and approved, he shall be automatically considered as having abandoned the position and having constructively tendered a resignation.
