EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

BACKGROUND:

On July 17, 2019, the TIRZ Board recommended approval of a Developer Agreement between City of Bay City and SAL Holding, LLC for the development of Cottonwood Park. Exhibit C provides an estimate of Phase I and Phase II. City Council approved agreement on September 12, 2019. Developer is seeking reimbursement on a Phase II. Phase II has an estimated cost of \$100,000 when complete. Reimbursements are limited to the amount approved by this agreement.

On November 19, 2020, the TIRZ Board recommended payment of up to \$20,689.77 for reimbursement of Phase II. City has paid \$20,167.68 based on documentation received.

Phase II Estimated Costs per Development agreement is \$100,000 (see Exhibit C)

Phase II Paid Expenditures as of 9-30-21 = \$20,689.77

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SAL Holdings LLC is requesting \$13,976.38 for Drainage Improvements.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Max Reimbursement remaining is 79,832.32 for Phase II.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends TIRZ Board approve up to \$13,976.38 for reimbursement of Phase II based on documentation received.
