1. CAPEX CONSULTING PRESENTATION REGARDING WHOLESALE RATE CALCULATION FOR THE CARRIZO HILL WASTEWATER - JEFF SNOWDEN

Jeff Snowden joined the meeting via Teams and announced that a 125-month flow data study had been completed. Mr. Snowden proposes increasing Carrizo Hill Water Supply Corporation wastewater fees to pay a percentage of the city's debt, operational costs and historical fees.

The agreement between the City of Carrizo Springs and Carrizo Hill Water Supply Corporation should stipulate that once the flowmeter is installed, the rates may increase.

7. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO GRANT A VARIANCE FROM THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ALLOW RICHARD BRAUNE TO USE AND STORE PROPANE GAS FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES ONLY AT 905 S. FIFTH STREET IN EXCHANGE FOR EXECUTING A PERMANENT NATURAL GAS SERVICE TERMINATION CONTRACT WITH THE CITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT SUBJECT TO CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL

City Manager Azalia Garcia presented Council with the Carrizo Springs Park Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that will serve as the city's primary public fundraising tool, in addition to the general fund for the city's park system.

According to City Manager Azalia Garcia, Special Counsel Bobby Maldonado will donate his legal services to create the Carrizo Springs Park Foundation non-profit organization. The board of directors would consist of City Council members.
