# 1. RECESS SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Dina Ojeda-Balderas recessed Special City Council Meeting at 6:01 p.m.

# A. MOBILE HOME ORDINANCE WORKSHOP

Special Counsel Carlos Hernandez presents Council with the updated mobile home ordinance with City Council's recommendations.

Mayor Pro Tem Sandra C. Little inquires on how many mobile homes are currently within the city limits. Code Enforcer Arnold Aguilar states that there is currently a total of two hundred mobile homes and the majority of the mobile homes do not have a 5-year non-variance permit.

Councilor Oscar E. Puente suggests that the double wide mobile homes in residential areas should not be rented, only mobile homes that are in mobile home parks may be rented. Mr. Puente also states that the mobile homes should face front toward the street.

City Council agrees that existing mobile home owners must apply for a 5-year non-conforming variance permit and comply with the ordinance. If the owner does not comply, they will be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500 and will be required to remove the mobile home with a time frame of 1 year.

Existing mobile home renters will be notified that they will have 1 ½ years to move out of the mobile homes and will not be allowed to renew their lease once the ordinance is approved.

Special Counsel Carlos Hernandez states that they will work on updating mobile home Ordinance No. 781 and reschedule the item in a future meeting.
