Mayor/Council Comments

Mayor Fahringer spoke regarding the Chase City Volunteer Fire Department fundraiser Rodeo. He reported they had close to 1000 people in attendance. Fahringer went on to thank everyone that came & participated. He said it was a huge success that drew people to our area. Vice-Mayor Bohannon thanked everyone for showing up. He commented that the new building looks nice. He went on to remind everyone of the fly in on October 28. Council Member Wilson said that the rodeo was the first event she has seen where nothing negative was said. She thought it was wonderful. Council Member Whitaker thanked everyone who came out and supported the rodeo. He thanked Town Manager Forbes on all his hard work on the new building and said it looked great. He went on to say that Chris Hudson did a great job on the building and painting. Whitaker thanked the Police Department for all their hard work. He also thanks Treasure Petersen and the ladies at the town office for all their hard work and all they put up with. Council Member Hatcher said the building looks great. Council Member Wilson said she had recently went to the Thyne Memorial. She went on to remark that she learned so much during her time there & said everyone should go at least once.

Town Manager's Oral Report

Town Manager Forbes started out by thanking everyone that helped with the new town office. He also thanked the ladies at the town office for all their hard work. He said the Dollar General Market is underway. Forbes reported that he had several meetings this month. He and IDA Chairman Hightower met with people from Dominion Energy regarding the transmission lines. He said he also had gone to the Thyne Memorial and commented that he actually went to school there. Mr. Forbes said that we passed the annual FAA inspection out at the airport but that we will need a new wind meter. They are currently checking on costs. The Town Manager said they had made multiple visits to look at dump trucks but can not find one in our budget so far. He said the fair is in town this week, we have movie night at the pavilion on Oct 27 & trunk or treats on Oct 31. This year part of Main Street will be closed down for trunk or treat. Town Manager Forbes said he anticipates the end of October for renovation completion on the new town office and the official move should take place then.
