The Regular Meeting of the Building/Code Enforcement/Public Safety Sub-Committee of the City of Coachella was called to order at 2:08 p.m. by Chair Beaman Jacinto.

2. Presentation on the Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) by Lt. Andy Martinez, with Garrett Langley and Jesse Mund with Flock Safety. Cost for the program is \$225,000 for 100 cameras, a reoccurring annual subscription cost, and \$25,000 for a one-time installation cost (100 cameras).

3. Presentation from Volunteers in Medicine by Rosa Lucas, with an introduction from Tom Cox with the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG). Subject included her efforts with the homeless population, a lack of city-wide efforts to offer housing and trash pickup for the homeless, and weed abatement in the encampments to avoid fire season and remove poisonous plants. *(Mr. Cox had to leave the meeting early and spoke briefly for the introduction.)*
