Chair Avila wanted to know who the parks belong to in Mecca and better drainage in the water retention in residential due to the damage after a rainstorm. He would like to see other sports leagues go live on Facebook to give a chance of community members to see the game.

Commissioner Hernandez would like an update on a time frame for the lights for the Soccer fields and would like to know if it can be done sooner.

Public Works Director's Comments:

Staff let the public and commissioners know that soccer fields 1 and 2 lights were approved, but it will take a year and a half to get that project going. Once it gets closer, they will bring it back to the Commissioners for review. Staff also explained what water retention basins are used for. Staff will let the Commissioners know about Taco's and Tequila's event on October 21.
