Kristy Lucas recently applied for an Alcohol Beverage Outlet card (ABO) which has been denied by the DeSoto Parish Sheriff's Office per Lt. Sonya Sharrow. Her place of employment is The Party Shop in Mansfield, LA. Alcohol is the primary commodity sold in this store. The reason for the denial is due to a felony arrest and conviction. The details are as follows:

- Ms. Lucas was arrested by the Sabine Parish Sheriff's Office on a fugitive warrant for Vernon Parish 05/11/2021.
- Ms. Lucas was found guilty in the 30th Judicial District Court (Vernon Parish) for Monetary Instrument Abuse and was sentenced to 8 years in the Louisiana Department of Corrections, 8 years suspended, and 2 years supervised probation, beginning 11/02/2023 and ending 11/02/2025.

Don D. Hunter recently applied for an Alcohol Beverage Outlet card (ABO) which has been denied by the DeSoto Parish Sheriff's Office per Lt. Sonya Sharrow. His place of employment is the Logansport Truck Stop in Logansport, LA. Alcohol is not the primary commodity sold in this store. The reason for the denial is due to a felony arrest and conviction. The details are as follows:

- Mr. Hunter was arrested by SPD on 07/06/2018 for Possession of Schedule II, Possession of Schedule I, Possession with Intent to Distribute Schedule II.
- Mr. Hunter pleaded guilty in the 1st Judicial District Court, Caddo Parish on 09/19/2018 to Possession with Intent to Distribute Schedule II and was sentenced to the Louisiana Department of Corrections for 7 years, 7 years suspended; 3 years supervised probation and \$2500.00 fine.
- Mr. Hunter's probation was revoked on 01/25/2021 and the previous imposed sentence of 7 years HL imposed. He was released on 12/31/2021 and remained on supervised parole until 07/25/2025.

In conclusion, according to the Qualifications of Applicants Permits LSA R.S. 26:280 which requires a person to be of good character and reputation, Don D. Hunter was denied.

To Whom It May Concern:

Mercedes Jackson recently applied for an Alcohol Beverage Outlet card (ABO) which has been denied by the DeSoto Parish Sheriff's Office per Lt. Sonya Sharrow. Her place of employment is Lott's O'Luck Casino in Mansfield, LA. Alcohol is not the primary commodity sold in this store. The reason for the denial is due to a felony arrest and conviction. The details are as follows:

- Ms. Jackson was arrested by Mansfield Police on October 20, 2025, for Unauthorized Entry of an Inhabited Dwelling.
- Ms. Jackson withdrew her not guilty plea and entered a plea of guilty to the charge of Unauthorized Entry of an Inhabited Dwelling in the 42nd Judicial District Court. The sentence of the court is that she been confined to the Louisiana Department of Corrections for 4 years, at hard labor, which is suspended. She is placed on 3 years supervised probation and pays a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00 plus court costs and \$200 for the cost of prosecution. The Court will defer consideration of Article 893 until Ms. Jackson's successful completion of probation.

In conclusion, according to the Qualifications of Applicants Permits LSA R.S. 26:280 which requires a person to be of good character and reputation, Mercedes Jackson was denied.
