

DOUGHERTY COUNTY COMMISSION
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES

April 12, 2021

The Dougherty County Commission met for a Special Called Meeting immediately following the Work Session in Room 100 of the Albany-Dougherty Government Center on April 12, 2021. Chairman Christopher Cohilas presided and called the meeting to order at 11:21 am. Commissioners present were Victor Edwards, Gloria Gaines, Russell Gray, Clinton Johnson, Anthony Jones and Ed Newsome. Also present were County Administrator Michael McCoy, Assistant County Administrator Scott Addison, County Attorney Spencer Lee, County Clerk Jawahn Ware, and other staff. The public and representatives of the media participated in person, via live streaming of the meeting on the County's Facebook page and the government public access channel.

The Chairman called for consideration of the recommendation from Public Works to apply for a Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) - Safety Action Plan (SAP) from the Georgia Department of Transportation for a 70% grant that requires a 30% match. Funding is available in TSPLOST and will be used on the installation of new signage and/or the repair of existing signage along 6 roads (~24.6 miles).

Commissioner Johnson moved for approval. Upon a second by Commissioner Jones, the motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss the Commission, the meeting adjourned at 11:22 a.m.
