# City of Dripping Springs Transportation Committee TxDOT – June Meeting Updates

### **Construction Updates**

- RM 150 Widening Project
  - Complete and will be removed from the next update
- Rob Shelton Sidewalks
  - Complete and will be removed from the next update
- US 290 Overlay Project
  - TXDOT will overlay US 290 from the Blanco CL to east of RM 165. This project will re-stripe the RM 165 intersection along US 290 to improve safety. Low Bidder was Lone Star Paving. Expect to start in Late July 2023.
- RM 1826 Overlay
  - TxDOT will overlay RM 1826 from just north of nutty brown road to about 0.5 miles south of Darden Hill Rd. The project was low bid by Lone Star Paving and work will commence in late July or early August
- RM 12 Overlay
  - TxDOT has an overlay project on RM 12 from RM 150 to the City of Wimberley.
     The project was low bid by
- US 290 at Trautwein
  - Hays County led project which will let July 2024( Late June Letting).

## US 290 Updates CSJ 0113-07-070

- Development ongoing for the schematic.
- District is working with a PS&E consultant to begin design efforts. Negotiation of their scope is ongoing.
- Meetings with affected property owners to begin soon and project is still on track for a fall public meeting / hearing.

## RM 1826 Updates (US 290 to RM 150)

Feasibility study underway. Development ongoing

#### **Pending Action Items/ Updates**

- Signal improvement and donation agreement at for Roger Hanks at RM 12 is ongoing.
- The donation agreement for the signal at Caliterra is complete. . Schedule for construction is TBD as we are pending issuance of a notice to proceed. . Documents (COI and Bonds) need to be finalized by the owner and then an NTP can be issued.
- TxDOT has begun the Donation agreement with Cortaro to add the LTL along RM 12 to Cortaro Dr. No update this month.
- TxDOT has prepared options for US 290 at Sawyer Ranch but we will need to
