Farmers Market Manager Report for 08/17/2023 Meeting

Market News:

- Averaged 39 vendors/market (-4 from June) (-1 from July 2022)
- 321 customers/market (-35 from June) (-11 from July 2022)
- Total sales per market: \$14,149 (-2,500 from June) (+1,000 from July 2022)
- Average per vendor: \$385 (-17 from June) (-16 from July 2022)
- Year two of drought has farmers dropping, with expectation of little to no produce for remainder of August.
- Despite slow-but-steady growth through June, July Saturday markets took a sharp drop with the departure of produce vendors, with none showing at last two markets. Average vendor sales per market ended up at: May \$141, June \$197, July \$209.

Vendor Issues:

Following up on last month's report on Hamilton Pool: After warning their vendor (Ryan) at the 7/5 market, he was again tardy at 7/26 market and I informed him he was no longer welcome. Though we talked after market, he had told his dairy customers that HP would not be bringing dairy anymore. Owner Sean Kattner called me and we met the next week to discuss his vendor and to walk through the application update for dairy, which he had not submitted after months of reminders. Sean said he'd released Ryan – though I did see a photo of Ryan at another market a week later. Hamilton Pool's updated application is in this month's packet and will be a point of discussion for their Dairy Farmer (also Terra Purezza's Dairy Farmer).

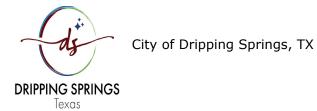
