Summary/Background: Garry Childs was a Hays County Master Naturalist and a Charro Ranch Park volunteer from 2010 - 2018. Garry was heavily involved in the development and maintenance of Charro Ranch Park. He particularly enjoyed the area of the park known as “The Grove”.

In memory of Garry, two signs were requested to be placed at both ends of “The Grove” along the trail. The signs were to read “Garry Child Memorial Grove – Hays County Master Naturalist & Dedicated Charro Ranch Park project lead, 2010 – 2018”.

The cost to manufacture and install the signs is \$445. This amount would be taken out of Charro Ranch Supplies (100-400-64012).

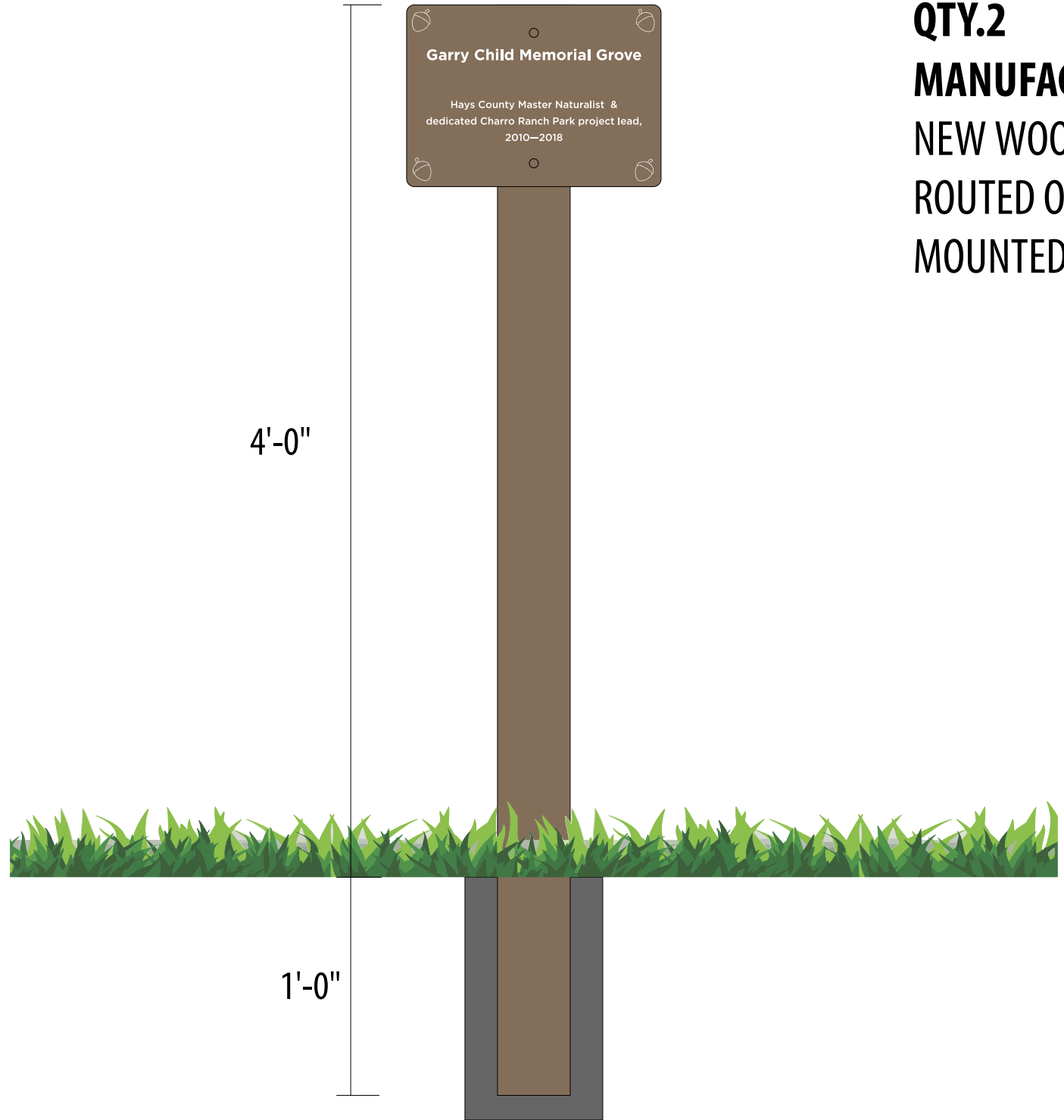

Summary/Background: Founders Memorial Pool has recently experienced an increase of minor vandalism and trespassing. Temporary cameras within the facility have captured images of an individual scaling the fence and going into the pool during late night/early morning hours.

It is the recommendation of Roman Baligad, Emergency Management Coordinator, to install a permanent cameras to continue to capture images and alert staff when unwanted activity is happening at Founders Pool. The new cameras will be an extension of a current monitoring system at Founders Memorial Park.

This camera system will be in place and active year-round. The Aquatic & Athletic Manager will have access to the cameras from their desktop to help monitor the activities at the pool.

The \$7,175.32 plus tax includes the cameras, hardware and installation and will be taken out of Founders Memorial Pool Supplies expense line (100-400-64013).

Summary/Background: The purpose of The Sponsorship program is to give local businesses an opportunity to give back to the community by helping provide family friendly programs and events.

In the past, staff has solicited sponsors for each individual event and customized each sponsorship agreement to meet the needs of the sponsor. This is a year-round sponsorship program that includes recognition for each sponsor at all existing and new events by the Parks & Community Services Department. If a business is interested in becoming a title sponsor for an event, a customized agreement and sponsorship fee will be created.
