## SECOND AMENDMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, GEORGIA AND SAFEbuilt GEORGIA, LLC

**THIS SECOND AMENDMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AREEMENT** is made effective as of the date of the last signature below by and between City of Fayetteville, Georgia (Municipality) and SAFEbuilt Georgia, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of SAFEbuilt, LLC, (Consultant). - 1. The above recitals are acknowledged as true and correct and are incorporated herein.
- 2. Agreement, Exhibit B, 1. Fee Schedule is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by Exhibit A hereto incorporated.
- 3. All other conditions and terms of the original Agreement and Amendment One not specifically amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

## 1. FEE SCHEDULE

- Municipality will promptly notify Consultant of any revisions or amendments to Municipal Fee Schedule
- Municipality will periodically review its Municipal Fee Schedule and valuation tables and make adjustment to reflect increases in the cost incurred by Consultant in providing Services
- Beginning January 01, 2025 and annually thereafter, the hourly rates listed shall be increased based upon the annual increase in the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics or successor thereof, Consumer Price Index (United States City Average, All Items (CPI-U), Not Seasonally adjusted, All Urban Consumers, referred to herein as the "CPI") for the Municipality or, if not reported for the Municipality the CPI for cities of a similar size within the applicable region from the previous calendar year, such increase, however, not to exceed 4% per annum. The increase will become effective upon publication of the applicable CPI data. If the index decreases, the rates listed shall remain unchanged.
