

### Why do you want to be on a Fridley Commission?

I care very deeply for this community. I want everyone that lives here to thrive here.

We are a small town in a big city, very similar to where I grew up. This "small town in a big city" positions Fridley to be incredibly unique – Fridley can be flexible and cutting-edge while still being connected and united with the community.

I have lived in Fridley for 16+ years. In this time, I have observed a lot of changes in our city – mostly good. I agree with the HRA and city's recent decisions to bring in multi-family housing and believe it is appropriate and realistic development for our city.

I want this city to continue to be a city that young adults and families return to because they're proud of where they grew up and they love this city and want the same for their kids. My son is 10 and I would be so happy if one day he returned to raise his family here and invest in this community like my husband and I do.

I want Fridley to remain affordable but alter that "drive through" reputation by seeing our city develop as a modern place to live, work, and play.

Giving the residents our very best is paramount. To me that means finding ways to increase tax revenues without imposing the entire burden directly on home-owner residents. Also important -cultivating programs for residents to return their properties to their original, simple glow.

### What skills, strengths, and abilities do you believe you will add to the commission?

Authentic curiosity and critical thinking - Learning desired outcomes of our community and educating residents are key to our mission. Making decisions that produce long term residents would be my main focus while accepting that critics and nay-sayers rarely have a holistic view needed to make sound assessments of recent and upcoming choices for our city.

I have a fundamental understanding of the economic development process, land development and commercial real estate in general. I attribute that capacity to unconscious assimilation of those concepts from 16 years of selling in the commercial construction industry. I have resources for mentorship from professional relationships as I uncover gaps in my understanding.

Sales experience – aside from selling in commercial construction (which is both a previous and current professional role), I spent time in packaging, insurance, and market research. All lending to good overall experience, understanding of commerce, supply chain, psychology).

Other professional experience – project admin/contracts, small business owner

Community Experience – being active in many community organizations supports organic connections and discussions with local residents and friends about their desires and concerns.
