- 1. Approval of Minutes of the February 15, 2022 City Council Development meeting**
Board Member Lopez motioned to approve minutes, second by Board Member King; 3-0
- 2. Discussed proposed text amendment to Article 9: Sign Standards to add portable illuminated signs as a permissible use**

Senior Planner Jonathan Tooley gave a PowerPoint presentation. He stated staff has been asked to investigate adding portable illuminated signs as a permissible use. The city is entering into an agreement for a ride share program that will implement illuminated signs on the exterior of the vehicle. Article 9: Sign Standards currently only allow an exception for portable non-illuminated signs. Staff will present research on the use and facilitate discussion on the amendment.

Board Member Lopez asked what type of messages would be allowed. Mr. Tooley stated mainly city events and advertising, but they would require city approval.

Chairman Del Bosque asked what the process for the advertising approval would be. Transportation Director Walter Shumac stated they would have to submit an application.

Mr. Lopez stated concern with inappropriate advertisements. Deputy City Manager Bill Hills stated if it becomes a problem at a point in time, it could be brought back to CCDC and Council to adjust.

There being no further discussion on this item Chairman Del Bosque stated the committee supports the request.

3. Proposed Street Name Change request to change SW 2nd Street, NW 2nd Street and Stadium Drive to Dolores Huerta Drive


Chairman Del Bosque stated he would like to table this item to get Councilman Humphreys input on this request since it is in his district.
