TITLE: Order Adopting Budget Procedure for Crime Control and Prevention District

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve

ANALYSIS:

The Local Government Code (LGC) outlines the procedure by which a crime control and prevention district must adopt its budget. The LGC also allows a crime control and prevention district to formally adopt an alternative procedure to that outlined in the law, as long as the alternative procedure provides for public hearings related to the budget.

BODY

AN ORDER OF THE GRAND PRAIRIE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT ADOPTING BY RULE ALTERNATIVE PROCEDURES FOR THE ADOPTION OF ITS ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Grand Prairie Crime Control and Prevention District was approved by voters on May 12, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Prairie Crime Control and Prevention District is funded by a one-quarter-cent sales tax; and

WHEREAS, annual budget process for a crime control and prevention district is outlined in Section 363.204 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 363.204(f) of the Texas Local Government Code allows the board of a crime control and prevention district to adopt by rule an alternative procedure for the adoption of its annual budget as long as that alternative procedure provides for public hearings on the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Grand Prairie Crime Control and Prevention District desires to adopt an alternative procedure for the adoption of its annual budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GRAND PRAIRIE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT THAT:

SECTION 1. Prior to the adoption of the annual budget for the Grand Prairie Crime Control and Prevention District, a draft of the budget shall be presented to the Grand Prairie Finance and Government Committee.

SECTION 2. The presentation of the draft budget to the Finance and Government Committee shall take place during the month of July in every year as part of the budget review process for the City of Grand Prairie.

SECTION 3. After the draft budget is presented to the Finance and Government Committee, a final draft budget shall be presented to the Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors.

SECTION 4. The final draft budget shall be presented to the Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors on or before August 17 of every year.

SECTION 5. The hearing for the final draft budget before the Crime Control and Prevention District shall be a public hearing pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act. Citizen comments shall be received at the hearing.

SECTION 6. Immediately after the public hearing, the Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors shall approve or deny the final draft budget. The Board may approve or deny the final draft budget in whole or in part.

SECTION 7. All final budget documents produced after the public hearing before the Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors shall clearly state the tax rate for the budget, as well as any proposals that were either approved or denied by the Board.

SECTION 8. After the final draft budget is presented to the Crime Control and Prevention District Board of Directors in accordance with these rules, the final budget shall be presented to the Grand Prairie City Council.

SECTION 9. The hearing for the final budget before the Grand Prairie City Council shall be on or before August 17 of every year.

SECTION 10. The hearing for the final budget before the Grand Prairie City Council shall be a public hearing pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act. Citizen comments shall be received at the hearing.

SECTION 10. After the public hearing, the Grand Prairie City Council shall approve or deny the final budget.
