As per photos, highlighted in red, haul off rubble and debris. Demo the existing stwo columns using a demo hammer. Haul off additional rubble and debris down using a demo hammer. Salvage and set aside existing cast stone cap. Brace co place temporarily. Dowel and epoxy rebar into the pier pads where required and column using a new CMU core. Install 22 gauge wall ties throughout the CMU b block using wet cement. Rebuild the column using new and original stone of besusing a custom blended mortar of reasonable match. Rebuild the brick column ubest available match. Includes wire and sloshing core. Install new 3" X 5" X 5/16 galvanized angle irons resting on existing columns piers. 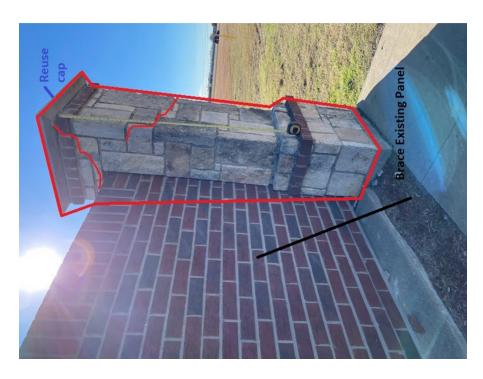
