





Economic Overview 12/31/2021

The Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) maintained the Fed Funds target range at 0.00% to 0.25% (Effective Fed Funds are trading <0.10%). The FOMC began reducing monthly security purchases during Nov 2021 and then increased the paced at the December meeting. Projections for target range increases shortened to late spring or early summer 2022. Third Quarter GDP posted +2.3% (Final). December employment reflected U-2 dropping to 3.9% and Non-Farm Payroll adding 199k net new jobs (Three Month Average NFP = 365). Crude oil reversed recent declines and bounced back to +/-\$75 per barrel. The Stock Markets reached new highs. Many domestic economic indicators remain positive. The Build Back Better legislation stalled in the Senate. The Debt Ceiling was increased to \$31+ trillion, easing any near-term funding pressures. Inflation remained well over the FOMC 2% target and does not appear positioned to decline in the near term. The Yield Curve shifted higher primarily six months and longer.












The entities will pay a pro-rata share of the election cost; however, the cost for each entity may increase depending on election cancellations.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HEWITT, MCLENNAN COUNTY, TEXAS, ORDERING A JOINT GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR WARD 1, PLACE 2, WARD 2, PLACE 2, AND WARD 3, PLACE 2; DESIGNATING POLLING LOCATIONS; ORDERING NOTICE OF ELECTION TO BE GIVEN AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF ELECTION SERVICES CONTRACT, AND ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING AND ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS AND DATES/TIMES OF OPERATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEWITT, TEXAS THAT:

- Section 1. An election is hereby ORDERED to be held on May 7, 2022, for voting in a General Election to elect one (1) person for each position to serve the full term of two (2) years for three (3) City Council Members in Ward 1, Place 2; Ward 2, Place 2; and Ward 3, Place 2. The Election will be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code and the Election Services Contract by and between McLennan County and other governmental entities. The first day to file an application for place on the ballot with the City Secretary is Wednesday, January 19, 2022, at 8:00 AM, with the last day for filing to be Friday, February 18, 2022, at 5:00 PM, in accordance with Election Codes Sections 143.006 and 143.007.
- Section 2. The Mayor is hereby directed to issue the Order of General Election attached as Exhibit "A" as required by the Texas Election Code in the form provided by the McLennan County Election Administrator.
- Section 3. The General Election will be administered by the McLennan County Election Administrator pursuant to a joint election agreement and a contract for Election Services. For the purpose of this election, all election officials shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the election services contract. The Elections Administrator will serve as Early Voting Clerk. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Contract for Election Services with the McLennan County Elections Administrator.
- <u>Section 4.</u> McLennan County will execute Joint Election Services Contract and Agreements with Bellmead, Crawford, Gholson, Hewitt, Lacy Lakeview, Lorena, Mart, McGregor, Waco, Woodway, Bosqueville ISD, Crawford ISD, La Vega ISD, Lorena ISD, Mart ISD, Midway ISD, and Waco ISD.
- <u>Section 5</u>. The locations of Early Voting Vote Centers and information on dates/hours of operations, as provided for by the Joint Election Agreement, are as follows:

The specific voting machines to be used shall be provided by McLennan County in accordance with the Contract for Elections Services with the McLennan County Elections Administrator.

Section 8. Notice of the elections hereby ordered shall be given in accordance with Texas state law. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to publish and/or post, in the time and manner prescribed by law, all notices required to be published and/or posted in connection with the conduct of these elections.

As a result of an increase in the landfill tipping fee at The City of Waco Landfill, effective February 21, 2022, the solid waste generated inside McLennan County will increase from \$35,25 to \$45.00 per ton. All construction and demolition wastes will increase to \$55.00 per ton. We will be passing this cost thru to the City of Hewitt. The net increase of \$10.00 per ton will be passed on to your residents and commercial accounts in the following manner:

Residential 3.31% increase Commercial 2.30% increase Industrial 8.35% increase

All construction and demolition wastes will increase to \$55.00 per ton. A minimum charge of \$10.00 will apply to all customers of the landfill.

There is <u>no</u> residential fee change to City of Waco residents who have their residential garbage collected by the City of Waco Solid Waste Services.
