**NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. Discussion of public outreach projects

Landscape plans for Lake Worth Station have been approved. Staff is waiting for permits to be submitted. Dave McGrew approved those plans during Site Plan approval process in 2022.

Concerns were raised by the Board and several members attended the Commission meetings. Commission supported asked for reconfiguration due to the old pine trees on site. The Board wanted for more trees to be saved, which has happened. Later, Mr. Hernandez requested and received a large grant from the CRA for an interactive nature park. The plans were provided to the CRA and they were approved. Annie Greening emailed Board members that the purview of the Board does not include the review of plans. The question remains, in the opinion of staff, do the plans suffice? Staff states a minor site plan is required for changes to the approved site plans. Board members questions how the new plans were approved by Dave McGrew. Some members believe there was a park shown near the tracks on the plans. Damage to pine tree roots is not evident until years later.

Board discusses the L & M properties and the disposition of any trees that may remain.

Concern for the spaces on Lake & Lucerne where trees are missing. FDOT may be re-paving
