10. Resolution 2022-01-01: Consider budget adjustment for the Police Department to use confiscated funds

APPROVING A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT FOR POLICE EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING

WHEREAS, the City Police Department is lawfully authorized to confiscate certain property that is used in the violation of law; and

WHEREAS, subject to Council approval, the City Police Department is allowed to utilize confiscated funds for the acquisition of public safety equipment and services; and

WHEREAS, there exists a certain amount of unused funds that have previously been confiscated by the Police Department, and those funds are available for use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Leeds that:

- 1. The Recitals above are true, correct, and included herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. The City Clerk shall adjust the City budget in such a manner as to allow for the use of confiscated funds, not to exceed \$53,000.00, to purchase and to outfit a police vehicle.
- 3. The City Clerk shall adjust the City budget in such a manner as to allow for the use of confiscated funds, not to exceed \$4,000.00, for the purpose of paying the costs of DARE Training and travel for City officers.
- 4. The Mayor and staff shall have the full authority to do those things, perform those functions, make such decisions, and to sign necessary documentation in order to carry out and fully complete the actions so authorized herein.

RESOLUTION NO: 2022-01-02

AUTHORIZATION OF BUDGET ADJUSTMENT: FUNDING EXISTING EMPLOYEE POSITIONS

WHEREAS, certain City employee positions currently exist within the City; however, those positions have not been funded due to various budget constraints; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested that those certain positions now be funded to curtail the need for excessive overtime in the Police Department and to assist the Administration Department with various accounting-based needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Leeds, Alabama, as follows:

- 1. The City budget is hereby amended in a manner to accommodate the personnel actions as identified on Exhibit A as attached hereto at a cost not to exceed \$325,443,00.
- 2. The Mayor and City staff are hereby authorized to perform all actions necessary in order to accomplish the actions herein approved.
