VIII. New Business

- Discussion of extending the Shepler winter boat program

- Continuing to make good progress with winter boats, but do not want to step in to winter service until things are 100% ready
 - Will have winter boats in the water by December 2nd, but want to have 2 winter boats completely ready before starting service
- Looking for permission to extend the Shepler's service through December 15, 2024 and have Arnold Transit begin service December 16, 2024
 - Mayor spoke with Andy McGreevy of the Mackinac Island Transportation Authority and he is on board with the service extension through December 15, 2024
- In the future Arnold Transit would like to run fast boats as long as and as early as they can (as long as weather agrees)
- Arnold Transit is also requesting approval to run the Straits of Mackinac II in addition to the current schedule for private groups
 - Fine by Council and does not need approval as this is service being provided in addition to their approved schedule

Motion made by Myers, seconded by Sehoyan, to approve the extension of Shepler's Ferry service through December 15, 2024 with the same continued schedule, and to have the City Clerk notify the Mackinac Island Transportation Authority of the service extension.

- GDS Draft Consulting Agreement
 - GDS is a consulting group that works with various utilities on regulatory processes and rates
 - Company is located out of Georgia, but have an employee, Rich Polich who is located in Michigan
 - Attorney Evashevski sent an edited version of the draft consulting agreement provided by Mr. Polich with her recommended changes to fit the City's needs
 - Attorney Evashevski recommends engaging the services of GDS in order for the City to begin the process of regulating the ferry boat companies in a manor that they have not done in the past as there have not previously been any monopoly issues
 - GDS will provide a scope of work, a list of individuals who would be working on the project, the rates of those individuals who would be working on the project, plus any estimates / do not exceed costs for the overall project
 - No retainer or engagement fee is required

Motion made by Myers, seconded by Sehoyan, to engage GDS under the terms of the redline edited general consulting agreement provided by Attorney Evashevski. Voting Yea: Chambers, Corrigan, Moskwa, Myers, Sehoyan

Dear Mayor and City Council:

At the meeting of the Planning Commission on November 12, 2024, there was discussion on the size of the house modules proposed by Cheryl Jaquiss for her new home. Per the City of Mackinac Island Motor Vehicle Ordinance, the maximum allowed size of a module is 14' x 44'. The applicant is proposing modules 56', 52' and 48' long, which is not allowed by our Ordinance. The concern from one of the Planning Commission members was the applicant would be using a variance for financial gain, or does the Council feel there are other reasons/concerns that would suffice for approval of a variance.

The Commission wanted to bring their concern to the attention of the City Council so they were aware of the issue when reviewing any vehicle permits for the project. The Commission agreed that the modules could be made to be shorter to comply with the Ordinance, and the contractor stated they are longer so they can "...get on and off the island as quickly as possible.".

- A guest would like no other items placed on the luggage cart.
 - o If there is room for additional items to be stacked on the cart and the guest is okay with this, then there is no charge.
 - o If there is room for additional items to be stacked on the cart and the guest is <u>NOT</u> okay with this, then the guest is subject to the Private Luggage Cart Fee \$40.00.
 - o If the guest takes up the entire cart and no additional items can be added to the cart, then there is no charge.
