HVAC license

During the June 28, 2022, meeting the committee directed city staff to develop a Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning ordinance. Currently under state law HVAC contractors do not need to be licensed. The local registration process is proposed to be for a period of two calendar years and cost \$50 to cover expenses. State law already requires a bond, as such the bond with the State of Minnesota will need to be provided as part of the registration process. Lozinski questioned the current practice in Marshall with electricians and venting. Gutman clarified that falls under the exception under (a) (1).

Motion by Lozinski, seconded by Meister to approve the proposed HVAC license and implementation. All voted in favor.
