


College Drive / Hwy 19 Reconstruction Project

Benefits of a Stop Sign




Improves traffic flow


Option 1 – Bumpouts

- Current layout design for Lyon St intersection
- Narrows the width of the roadway – shorter distance for pedestrians to cross




Option 2 – Bumpouts & Median

- Narrows the width of the roadway – shorter distance for pedestrians to cross
- Adds medians to provide pedestrian refuge between travel lanes
- Limits traffic movements (right-in/right-out)




Option 3 – Bumpouts & Crosswalk with Light

- Narrows the width of the roadway – shorter distance for pedestrians to cross at Lyon St
- Includes a crossing with a light that helps pedestrians cross College Drive
- Crosswalk type and location to be determined

(RRFB)




