Background Information:	<p>Staff would like to discuss with Council Labor Relations as it pertains to the 2021 Levy/Budget.</p> <p>13D.03 CLOSED MEETINGS FOR LABOR NEGOTIATIONS STRATEGY.</p> <p>§</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Subdivision 1.Procedure.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) The governing body of a public employer may by a majority vote in a public meeting decide to hold a closed meeting to consider strategy for labor negotiations, including negotiation strategies or developments or discussion and review of labor negotiation proposals, conducted pursuant to sections 179A.01 to 179A.25.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(c) The time of commencement and place of the closed meeting shall be announced at the public meeting.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(d) A written roll of members and all other persons present at the closed meeting shall be made available to the public after the closed meeting.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Subd. 2.Meeting must be recorded.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) The proceedings of a closed meeting to discuss negotiation strategies shall be tape-recorded at the expense of the governing body.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) The recording shall be preserved for two years after the contract is signed and shall be made available to the public after all labor contracts are signed by the governing body for the current budget period.</p>
