Helena Chemical

Helena has contacted the City regarding their intent for on-site demolition, with the City's participation. Helena will be responsible for managing the demolition of the Quonset building, with the City being asked to pay for 50% of the costs, not to exceed \$64,400 at the time of closing on the sale of the property.

Schwan Foods: Brad Snell conveyed favorable compliments on the City's performance on crack sealing work. For future replacement of runways, Schwan Foods suggests consideration for grooved paving surfaces.
