Council met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Jeffrey presiding.

All stood and recited the pledge of allegiance led by Mayor Jeffrey.

A motion was made by Brubaker and seconded by Kimmons to approve the agenda. Ayes: Jeffrey, Brubaker, Kimmons and Kyser. Nays: None. Absent: Davis.

A motion was made by Kyser and seconded by Brubaker to approve the minutes of the August 2, 2021, Council meeting as presented. Ayes: Jeffrey, Brubaker, Kimmons and Kyser. Nays: None. Absent: Davis.

City Manager introduced visitors Jason Zamkus from Zamkus and Associates, LLC, who would be presenting to the Council later in the meeting. He also introduced Dana Ulmer, Moberly's new Director of Public Utilities, who would be beginning his employment with the City of Moberly in September of this year.

Jason Zamkus, from Zamkus and Associates, LLC, gave a presentation on the 2021 Legislation Session.

The following bids were received for the repainting of the aquatic center located at 100 Rothwell Park Road, Moberly, MO 65270: **Jos. Ward Painting Company**, \$23,944 - brush blasting pool, \$11,498 - painting pool one coat, \$6.24 LF - removing and replacing caulk, patching anything in pool time and material not to exceed 40 hours, labor rate of \$76.40 material cost plus 10% mark up. **BAZAN Painting Company**, base bid, \$39,863. **CCIMW**, base bid, \$21,586. Brubaker seconded the motion. Ayes: Jeffrey, Brubaker, Kimmons and Kyser. Nays: None. Absent: Davis. The Resolution bill having previously been made available for public inspection was read by title one time. A motion was made by Brubaker and seconded by Kimmons to adopt the Resolution. Ayes: Jeffrey, Brubaker, Kimmons and Kyser. Nays: None. Absent: Davis.

Monthly reports were received from various departments.

Mayor Jeffrey nominated John Meystrik to be reappointed to the Moberly, Missouri Public Building Corporation Board. A motion was made by Kyser and seconded by Kimmons to reappoint John Meystrik to the Moberly, Missouri Public Building Corporation Board. Ayes: Jeffrey, Brubaker, Kimmons and Kyser. Nays: None. Absent: Davis.

The Council entered into a discussion of a Petition from Country Villa Apartments. In summary, the City of Moberly received a petition from Country Villa Apartment residents, their location is immediately northeast of the Moose Lodge's property. The Moose Lodge has held mud runs at the property in the

past; however, they have recently set up a dirt track for car racing. The resulting track takes the race cars within 50 feet of the adjacent housing with no buffers or barriers. Per zoning regulations for the location of the Moose Lodge, they would be required to get a conditional use permit through the Planning and Zoning Commission (P&Z) for outdoor activities, and they have not done that. City Staff has notified members of the Moose Board that they cannot have any further outdoor events like this in the future without first getting a conditional use permit through P&Z. All adjacent property owners would be notified of the process and be allowed to speak. It is unlikely that this type of activity would be approved, and if approved, it would have conditions on maintaining dust control, adding buffers and safety barriers and limited hours. The decision rests ultimately upon P&Z, but City Staff are confident that the close proximity of residential housing and the attached petition will likely prevent approval of a conditional use for this type of event in the future. The Moose Lodge currently has another similar event scheduled in August 2021. The Police department is aware that they do not have a permit or approval for this, and City Staff will continue their attempts at contact with Moose Lodge association with a formal letter letting them know that any future outdoor activity like this is not permitted and would be shut down.



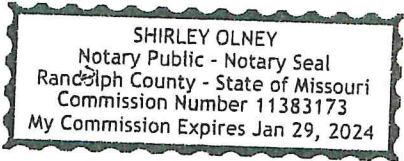

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING SECTION 46-340 OF THE MOBERLY CITY CODE
RELATING TO SPECIAL EVENTS.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MOBERLY, MISSOURI, TO-WIT:**

SECTION ONE: Section 46-340 of the Moberly City Code is hereby adopted to read as follows:

Sec. 46-340. – Special Events.

By Resolution, the City Council is authorized to temporarily suspend the requirement of a Conditional Use Permit for short-term housing rentals in all zoning districts and authorize short-term housing rentals as permitted uses in all zoning district during special events for a term not to exceed ten days.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption by the Council of the City of Moberly, Missouri, and its signature by the officer presiding at the meeting at which it was passed and adopted.

COMMENTS:

The proposed text amendment is written to give authorization for City Council to review and waive the Conditional Use Permit for Short-Term Housing Rentals in all zoning districts for a select period of time to not exceed ten (10) days.

The text amendment is intended to allow a special event function to apply for a waiver of the conditional use requirements in conjunction with their event for a possible increase in housing availability for the time period surrounding the special event.

Staff Comments:

Recommends changing wording in the proposed text to include application for special waiver permit to be done by the property owner in an effort to be sure that the properties have had a recent inspection and are viable for housing guests.

TEAP – Study for School

The City of Moberly has met with the Moberly School district regarding partnering in a TEAP (Traffic Engineering Assistance Program) to complete a traffic study in the area being proposed for the new alternative school. The area in question already has traffic concerns from the level of traffic produced from students, parents, staff and buses during start up and shut down. The new proposed school will add to that concern. The school would be required to complete a traffic study on their own as part of the site plan process.

With the TEAP program that can be applied for by the City, it is an 80/20 match up to a total project of \$10,000. If the school agrees to provide the matching funds, the TEAP has a high probability of getting funded and that would take care of the traffic study required by the City for public streets. We can perform a cultural resource survey of the approximately 18,000-feet of force main and three pump stations located around the City of Moberly, Randolph County, Missouri, for **\$9,850.00**. The survey will be conducted according to current federal, state, and tribal guidelines and consist of the following steps:

- 1.) An archival search will be performed to identify any previously recorded cultural resources (prehistoric or historic archaeological sites, historic architecture or bridges, and cemeteries) within the project area and one mile around it. The research will include a brief review of the local prehistory and history, with more detailed site specific information, as necessary. Information will be obtained from the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) in Jefferson City, the Missouri Historical Society in St. Louis, and at local historical archives or libraries, as needed.
- 2.) A field survey will be conducted of the proposed force mains and pump stations to determine the present condition of any previously recorded sites and to identify any new cultural resources. Along with the force mains, shovel tests will be placed at 30-meter intervals, if practical. Shovel tests will be placed across the pump station tracts in 30 meter wide transects. The excavated soil will be examined for cultural materials and replaced. If an archaeological site is identified, its boundaries will be determined by placing shovel tests in two transects at 5-meter intervals perpendicular to each other. Any artifacts found will not be collected but photographed with a scale. The site boundaries will be marked using GPS units and incorporated into an ArcGIS 10.8.1 map.
- 3.) The present condition of any archaeological resources will be determined as well as their potential significance. Cultural resources are **only** considered significant if they are associated with an important person or event in our history, are of



Copies of the report will be submitted to Jacobs for approval, who then will send the reports to the Missouri SHPO, The Osage Nation, and any other appropriate agencies for their review.

The archival search, survey, and report preparation should take approximately 15 to 25 business days to complete, weather permitting.


