AGENDA APPROVAL

Motion by Commissioner Harris, Seconded by Commissioner Kurtz to approve agenda as presented. Unanimously Approved.

FY2021 ROAD PAVING PROJECT

Morgan County was awarded \$522,282.63 in LMIG funding for the FY2021 road paving project, consisting of approximately 10 miles of resurfacing roads throughout the county. The county is required to match the award at 30% (\$156,684.79). An RFP was placed in mid-February for the project, and two bids were received. The county engineering firm reviewed the bids for completeness and recommend awarding the bid to the low bidder (Pittman Construction) in the amount of \$1,494,139.00. The other bid received from East Coast Grading Inc. totaled \$1,701,483.46.

MOTION by Commissioner Kurtz, Seconded by Commissioner Harris to award the FY2021 Road Paving Project to Pittman Construction Company in the amount of \$1,494,139.00 to be paid from TSPLOST Funds. Unanimously Approved.
