THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MADISON, GEORGIA, MET THIS DAY IN REGULAR SESSION.

MEETING WAS HELD ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation.

AGENDA APPROVAL

<u>Motion</u> by Commissioner McCormack, Seconded by Commissioner Riden to approve the agenda as presented. Motion Passed Unanimously.

MINUTES

January 16, 2024 BOC Meeting

<u>Motion</u> by Commissioner McCormack, Seconded by Commissioner Riden to approve the minutes as presented. Motion Passed Unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

Motion to accept as information the January 2024 payables and financials.

<u>MOTION</u> by Commissioner McCormack, Seconded by Commissioner von Hanstein to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion Passed Unanimously.

WEAVER ADMINISTRATIVE APPEAL

Dustin and Janeah Weaver are requesting an administrative appeal to Planning Director, Chuck Jarrell's denial of a property split based on subdivision regulations.

Jarrell stated that the Weaver's purchased 35.56 acres on Nolan Store Road. They followed all processes and obtained a building permit. The owners have applied for a loan to complete the construction of their home and the bank is requesting that a minimum of 5 acres be split out for collateral. However, in November of 2022, the BOC adopted new subdivision regulations and for minor subdivisions it allowed someone to split property on an existing road up to 5 parcels. The subject property was a 4-tract parcel that was split, but for a minor subdivision, it limited further splits on the property for 3 years. The subject property was split up and recorded on April 21, 2023. The property has enough road frontage of 654 feet to split but the 3-year rule is what caused the denial of the split.

Dustin Weaver addressed the Board. Mr. Weaver stated that he is a veterinarian and that he and his wife have lived in Morgan County for five years. He understands the challenges of an administrative variance but would like the Board to consider his request. He was unaware of the regulations and construction of his single-family residence is well underway. He has no intent to develop the land and plans to use the land to support beef cattle operations. The split request is to secure a lien on 5 acres of property to obtain financing from United Bank to complete the construction of the primary residence.

Commissioners expressed that the subdivision regulations were intended to slow development and preserve agriculture. It appears that the Weaver's intend to utilize their land for agricultural purposes and plan to continue in the conservation use program.

<u>MOTION</u> by Commissioner Riden, Seconded by Commissioner McCormack to grant Dustin Weaver's variance request to split 5 acres from his property. And to also have Chuck Jarrell draft text amendment language to address similar situations going forward. Motion Passed Unanimously.

STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

Communications/EMA Director, Amanda Proctor, is requesting approval for a statewide mutual aid agreement. The agreement would help ensure the timely provision of mutual aid assistance and reimbursement of costs incurred by parties who render mutual aid in emergencies. The agreement also provides the framework to support mutual assistance in managing an emergency or disaster occurring within any political subdivision that is a participating party, whether arising from a natural disaster, technological hazard, human-caused disaster, civil emergency, community disorders, insurgency, enemy attack, acts of terrorism, or other significant events or homeland security activities.

MOTION by Commissioner Riden, Seconded by Commissioner Harris to approve the Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement as presented. Motion Passed Unanimously.

2024-RES-002 PROBATE COURT TECHNOLOGY FEE

This resolution is a request of the General Assembly to enact local legislation for the Probate Court of Morgan County to assess and collect a \$5 surcharge for each civil action filed and each fine assessed by the court. This fee is specifically to help provide support for the technological needs of the Probate Court. The revenue generated would be used exclusively for:

- 1. Computer hardware and software purchases.
- 2. Lease, maintenance, and installation of computer hardware and software.
- 3. Purchase, lease, maintenance, and installation of audio-visual, imaging, scanning, facsimile, communications, recording, projection, printing equipment, and software.
- 4. Purchase of technical support services.

MOTION by Commissioner Harris, Seconded by Commissioner Riden to approve the SPLOST VIII IGA as presented. Motion Passed Unanimously.

BRIDGE SCOUR REPAIR PROJECT

The scope of the bridge scour repair project stems from the isolated flash flooding events that the county experienced on August 27, 2023. The county petitioned GADOT for funding for the project and was awarded up to \$225,000 less 30% for the work which was awarded on November 27, 2023. The RFP went out in December for 30 days as required by law, but no bids were received. The RFP deadline was extended two weeks and we received two bids on 01/31/2024. The bids were vetted, and the recommendation is to award the project to Concrete Constructors in an amount not to exceed \$183,943. The county's portion is \$55,182.90 with the remaining coming from grant funds.

<u>MOTION</u> by Commissioner Riden, Seconded by Commissioner Harris to award Concrete Construction the 2023 Bridge Scour Repair project not to exceed \$183,943. Motion Passed Unanimously.

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STAFF REPORT MORGAN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

PETITION FOR: TEXT AMENDMENT

Applicant: Morgan County Planning & Development

Zoning Ordinance: Morgan County Zoning Ordinance Article 4, Table 4.1

Summary

David J. Gerber is requesting a text amendment to add collision repair as a permitted use in the Heavy Industrial (I2) Zoning District. He is the owner/operator of DJ's Auto Painting and Collision, currently located in Social Circle, and is seeking to move his business to Woodkraft Road.

Currently, the language in the Morgan County Zoning Ordinance pertaining to automobile repairs and body shops in found in Table 4.1: *Automobile Repair Garage, mechanical and body shops, provided all operations are conducted in a building which shall not have any opening, other than a stationary window, within 100 ft. of a residential zoned district.* The use is permitted in C2, C3, and TCO Zoning Districts, and is a conditional use in MXD3.

Proposed Language

The applicant did not propose any language to go with his request to add the use to the I2 Zoning District, other than the request to make it a permitted use. Staff researched regulations related to automobile repair garages and proposes the following language, as the existing language is lacking.

Automobile Repair Garages (including paint and body shops)

The lot of record must be a minimum of five acres in order to operate an Automobile Repair Garage.

The applicant shall submit to the planning department written detailed site plans and landscaping plans for the property to be used including method proposed for improvement, drainage, parking and display areas, driveways for ingress and egress, signage and buildings to be built or existing buildings to be used in the operation of the business. Off-street parking spaces, site plans, landscaping and buffers, and signage shall be in accordance with the requirements for the applicable zoning district in which the property use is located.

A repair shop building shall be provided and shall meet all requirements of the current building code as adopted by Morgan County.

Setbacks for the zoning district shall be maintained. No vehicles may be displayed or parked on the public right-of-way.

All surface areas for motor vehicle traffic and/or parking shall be an asphalt or concrete surface which shall be maintained in good condition and free of damage. In no event shall vehicles be parked on grass or unprepared surfaces.

Required parking spaces for customers shall be designated separately from those areas used to store repaired motor vehicles or those awaiting repair.

An adequate turn-around area shall be provided so that vehicles shall not back out into traffic from the property.

Disabled or damaged vehicles shall not be permitted to remain in an exterior location unless screened from public view. Screened areas shall only be allowed in areas to the rear of the principal structure of the dealership. Screening fences surrounding storage areas shall be provided on any property line that abuts any right-of-way and any adjoining property.

Any change in business ownership or discontinuance in the use of the property for the purpose of a automobile repair garage shall cancel the repair garage's occupational tax certificate. To become licensed as an automobile repair garage again, all of the necessary requirements and physical improvements described herein must be met. A site plan and landscape plan shall be submitted to ensure compliance and an inspection shall be required.

No loud or boisterous noises, including outdoor public-address systems, shall emanate from the business, either by persons congregating there or by the playing of recording instruments, radios, and/or television sets or other sound-producing equipment.

All motor vehicle repairs shall take place inside the repair shop building. No motor vehicle repairs shall occur outside of the repair shop building.

Motor vehicle repair shops shall not be permitted within 300 feet of any property used for a school, park, playground or hospital or on a lot which is either adjacent to or directly across the street from any residential use.

Criteria for Consideration

From Section 19.4.5, Criteria for Considering a Text Amendment, in the Morgan County Zoning Ordinance:

- 1. The proposed amendment is consistent with the purpose and intent of this ordinance as stated in Article 1;
- 2. The proposed amendment supports or is compatible with the purpose and intent of the Comprehensive Plan;
- 3. The proposed amendment adequately addresses new or changing conditions to properly implement the Comprehensive Plan or the terms of this Zoning Ordinance;
- 4. The proposed amendment provides a benefit to the county as a whole;
- 5. The proposed amendment reasonably promotes the public health, safety, morality and general welfare.

Staff Comments

The request for a text amendment is not about a specific property, even though the applicant has a particular property in mind. Text amendments have the potential to affect all properties in the subject zoning district and should be reviewed with that in mind. Morgan County has limited industrially zoned property, with the majority located on Woodkraft Road. When considering whether the use is appropriate for industrial designation, thought should be given to the propensity of the use to create traffic, the type of traffic, noise, dust and other issues commonly associated with industrial uses. Staff feels the frequency of tow trucks, parts delivery trucks, occasional noise and potential for hazardous materials is applicable to industrial classification. Staff determines that the request meets Criteria #1 and #5.

As questions always arise regarding the applicant's proposed location, it is an 8 acre parcel (not yet recorded) on Woodkraft Road with an existing shop building and adjacent to poultry houses and other industrially zoned property. All of the language proposed by Staff is attainable at the proposed location. Of further interest is the prospect of the adjacent parcel to be used for automobile parts warehouses.

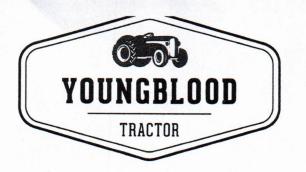

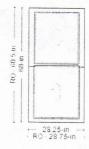
