I am writing on behalf of the Northeast Georgia Regional Solid Waste Management Authority ("the Authority") in regard to the Northeast Georgia Regional Solid Waste Management Plan. The Authority has approved a motion to recommend the update of the regional plan, last updated in 2011, in which your county is included. The plan would serve as the guiding document for solid waste and recycling efforts in your county and the region for the following ten years. It would include a list of needs, goals, and work items identified over a series of work sessions. The Authority recommends that your county participate in the plan update so that all ten counties can cohesively plan for a better future.

The Northeast Georgia Regional Commission will be facilitating the process and writing the plan. If participating, your county will be responsible for \$1,116.00 of the total \$30,000 fee for services. A draft resolution has been attached to this letter for the Board of Commissioners to review and formally adopt at your next regular meeting.
