MINUTES BOARD OF BUILDING STANDARDS CONFERENCE MEETING & CERTIFICATION HEARING June 25, 2021

The Board of Building Standards Conference Meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m., Friday, June 25, 2021 via videoconference, Chairman Timothy Galvin presiding.

CONSIDERATION OF THE MINUTES

Mr. Warner moved and Mr. McCafferty seconded to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2021 Certification Hearing and Conference Meeting.

Chairman Galvin called for the ayes and nays.

Motion carried unanimously.

CERTIFICATION HEARING

Chairman Galvin opened the hearing to hear testimony on the individuals and building departments appearing on the Final Certification Hearing Agenda in the Board's Meeting Packet at the Hearing tab. Ms. Foley informed the Board that the individuals and departments appear on the hearing agenda have been reviewed by the Certification Committee and determined to meet the requirements of certification. There being no testimony, Chairman Galvin closed the hearing.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

CR-1 Code Committee Report

Mr. Denk gave the committee's report included in the Board's Meeting packet at Tab CR-1:

The Code Committee met on June 24, 2021, via videoconference, with the following members present: Mr. Denk, , Mr. Johnson, Mr. Miller, Mr. Pavlis, Mr. Samuelson, Mr. Stanbery, Mr. Tyler, and Mr. Yankie. Board Chairman Galvin was also present.

The committee report is included in the June 25, 2021 Board Meeting Packet at tab CR-1 for the Board's consideration.

June 24, 2021 Code Committee Meeting

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Denk at 1:04 P.M.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Samuelson made the motion to approve the minutes of the Code Committee meetings held on March 25th, April 1st, April 22nd, and May 7th. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Recommendations of the Residential Construction Advisory Committee No items for consideration

Old Business

- Staff reminded the Committee of where we are on the tentative code adoption timeline that was established earlier in the year. Although good progress has been made reviewing the 2021 model codes, much work and coordination is still ahead. Staff is also continually hearing about the impact that COVID has had on the construction industry. Construction materials are very difficult to acquire, labor availability is limited, and material costs have increased significantly. Additionally, staff has continued concerns about moving forward with the code update process at this time with the regulatory restriction laws still in place. As a result, staff recommended continuing our work, but revisiting the established code development timeline next year. The committee agreed to revisit the timeline next year and continue with the work.
- Reconsideration of action taken on Petition 20-01 (adoption of the 2020 NFPA 70) -Staff presented an issue that has surfaced regarding the new Article 210.8(F) in the 2020 edition of NFPA 70 which the Committee recently recommended for adoption without amendment. Some HVAC systems, particularly HVAC units employing power conversion equipment may not have been designed to the newest industry standards, resulting in GFCI nuisance trips. Staff explained that the NFPA standards council, in December of 2020, had voted to not issue TIA 1529, which delayed the implementation of 210.8 (F) to January 1, 2023. Two additional TIAs, one broader in scope and one almost identical to TIA 1529 have since been proposed to delay the implementation of the GFCI requirement to January 1, 2023 allowing the HVAC manufacturers time to correct the problem. Staff recommended that the committee consider the adoption of the 2020 NFPA 70 to include TIA 1593. There was much discussion about the safety aspect of the requirement, whether all manufacturers equipment had the issue, whether manufacturers had a design solution in the works, whether it made sense to delay, and how to craft and in which OBC Chapter to locate an Ohio amendment. Mr. Miller made a motion to reconsider previous action to adopt the 2020 NFPA 70 without amendments. Mr. Pavlis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Pavlis made a motion to delete the GFCI requirement for variable speed HVAC. Mr. Stanbery seconded the motion. After discussion, both Mr. Pavlis and Mr. Stanbery withdrew their motions. Mr. Pavlis made a motion to table the issue until staff drafts language, for the Committee's review, that exempts HVAC

- systems employing power conversion equipment from the requirement. Mr. Miller seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- Terry Welker, representing the Ohio AIA, presented a cost impact report that evaluates moving from the currently referenced and adopted ICC/ANSI A117.1-2009 standard to the ICC/ANSI A117.1-2017 edition for new buildings only. Mr. Welker recommended that the Committee consider establishing a subcommittee to review the OBC Chapter 34 and how the ICC/ANSI A117.1-2017 applies to existing buildings. The committee was very appreciative of the analysis.
- Staff presented a letter and design concept drawings received from Mr. Jereme Kent of One Energy. Mr. Kent has had numerous communications with staff and is requesting that the Committee make a determination of whether a privately owned, managed high-voltage (138,000 V) substation located on the end-user's property would be within the scope of the Board's rules. Mr. Kent has been receiving different opinions from different building officials in Ohio and would like an understanding of where the Committee stands on the issue. Mr. Kent argues that his company is a utility (per the federal definition) and as such qualifies for an exception in the NEC. He expressed concern that Electrical Safety Inspectors are not familiar with high voltage systems and that if regulated by the Board's rules, that contractor licensing issues come into play. Staff shared that further research into the Revised Code and coordination with the PUCO/OPSB is needed. No action was taken by the Committee.
- Staff summarized where we are in Ohio in terms of the commercial energy code adoption. Summaries of the newer versions of the IECC-C and the ASHRAE 90.1 standards were provided to the committee for their review. Additionally, a preliminary energy savings publication and a draft cost effectiveness publication for Ohio was prepared by PNNL and provided to the Committee for their review. Staff will attempt to line up speakers to present the ASHRAE 90.1 and the IECC-C changes to the Committee at a future date in July or August.

Complaint and Investigation Consideration Status Report

August 20, 2021

To: Members of the Ohio Board of Building Standards (OBBS) for the August 20, 2021 Board Conference Meeting. The following list are new complaint(s) received after the previous Board meeting and are to be considered by the OBBS certification committee for recommendation to the full Board for a determination of action.

New Complaints:

A. Robert Kurtz, Former Building Official, Vermilion Township

On July 29, 2021, a complaint was received from Mr. Robert Baker, building official with Vermilion Township, indicating that previous building official Robert Kurtz had provided electrical inspections on projects for which he does not hold an Electrical Safety Inspector certification. Records were provided by Mr. Baker of electrical inspections signed-off by Mr. Kurtz during the course of several years from 2015. Mr. Kurtz provided a response in explanation of the circumstances of his actions and admitted that he did perform the inspections. See attached documents. Recommend dismissal of the complaint and consideration of disciplinary action based on information received.

B. Angela Cavanaugh, Building Official, Stark County

On August 12, 2021, a complaint was received from Michael Gainer, indicating that Stark County building official, Angela Cavanaugh had exceeded her authority related to the determinations of applicability of Ohio Building Code to an existing building use and agricultural exemption. Complainant renovated a barn and began using it for paid events, such as weddings and in July 2018 Ms. Cavanaugh issued an order for the complainant to comply with the Residential Code of Ohio. The Lawrence Township Fire department issued an order for violations based on its new commercial use. The complainant appealed the Stark County building order to the Stark County Board of Building Appeals which upheld the order. Complainant then appealed the Lawrence Township fire department order to Ohio Board of Building Appeals and then to Court of Common Pleas. On June 28, 2021 the Fifth District Court of Appeals who upheld the findings of the trial court which found that the building in question is not exempt from the building code. See attached documents. As indicated in complainant's correspondence, complainant intends to appeal to the Ohio Supreme Court. Board staff evaluated Ms. Cavanaugh's actions and found no violation of the Boards rules. Additionally as this matter involves pending litigation regarding a legal determination of whether the building is incident to the agricultural use of the property thereby exempt, Staff recommends dismissal with no further action.

C. Patrick Barnes, Lake County Residential and Electrical Safety Inspector

On August 11, 2021, a complaint was received from Nicky Vassil indicating that Lake County residential building and electrical inspector Patrick Barnes was unethical in his involvement of their pool project that was not bonded correctly when Mr. Barnes 'approved' a certification letter from a contractor for the electrical system and bonding of the pool. *See attached documents*. While Lake County's Building Official David Strichko notified the Board that Mr. Barne's actions are being addressed through Lake County's human resources

as well, Staff recommends authorization of an investigation into the actions of Patrick Barnes for evaluation of violations of the Board's rules.

Board of Building Standards Duties / Report Organization and Purpose

Revised Code § 3781.10(E) directs the Board of Building Standards to certify municipal, township, and county building departments and their personnel to enforce the administrative rules promulgated by the Board. As licensees of the Board, building departments and individuals certified by the Board are subject of review, investigation, and discipline by the Board for failure of proper enforcement of the Board's rules. Persons affected by the actions of Board-certified individuals and departments may file a complaint with the Board. Upon receipt of a complaint, Board Staff conducts an initial inquiry into the allegations and determines if there is enough basis to warrant further investigation. The complaint related to this report provided the basis for the Board to order staff to investigate.

This report provides a synopsis of the complaint, background, investigation findings, observations, applicable code requirements, as well as a conclusion and recommendation. This report provides adequate information to assist the Board in determining what actions, if any it may take regarding evidence related to specific violations of the Boards rules. It does not address the rights or obligations of parties to any previous or pending enforcement action by a building department in the enforcement of the Board's rules. Parties should consult with their legal counsel regarding these matters.

Allegation / Complaint Summary

On March 29, 2021, the State Fire Marshal and the Greenville fire department notified Board staff of a potential conflict of interest that involved the duties of certified master plans examiner Michael Bruns of the Miami County building department. The allegation stated that Mr. Bruns had reviewed his own documents produced by his company, Mote and Associates. Mr. Bruns had sealed the documents as the responsible party for the civil design of the project.

Background

The proposed project is a freezer expansion storage building by the Classic Carrier Company. The owner proposed to mitigate risks in the design for code compliance through various means to offset the requirement for fire suppression systems. The submitted plans included the civil engineering documents that were prepared and sealed by Michael Bruns. Mr. Bruns performed the plan review. [Exhibit 1-7]

Investigation Findings & Observations

Board staff interviewed Mr. Bruns and Mr. England regarding conflict of interest. It was determined that Mr. Bruns was the plan examiner in the early phases of the plan reviews. He did the reviews up to the point of the approval of the footings, foundations and slabs. He also reviewed the construction documents that included the civil drawings from Mote and Associates, which he is affiliated with, in the first round of submissions. It was at this point that he should have communicated to the building official of the necessity to recuse himself from reviewing the documents for code compliance. Staff verified that the sealed documents authored by Mote and Associates were sealed by Mr. Bruns. [Exhibit-1]

When the complaint was made, Board staff contacted the building official to discuss the matter. It was at this point that the project was reassigned to a different plan examiner. The project had been approved for three phased approvals while reviewed by Mr. Bruns. After that, the project review was reassigned to master plan examiner, Candy Goodall by Robert England, Miami County building official for the balance of the project.

Mr. Bruns indicated to Board staff that he had recused himself from other projects in the past when his company had authored construction documents requiring approval by the department which he works for as a master plans examiner. Mr. England stated that this was a true statement by Mr. Bruns and was aware that these recusals had occurred specifically in the past 7-8 years.

Mr. Bruns also indicated that he did not appropriately consider that his involvement in this project would be a conflict of interest due to his company being in contract to provide documents for the project for civil engineering only. He indicated that he now realizes the error and he is establishing protocols for himself and Mote and Associates to ensure that a conflict will not occur again with Miami County code enforcement.

Board staff reviewed the submittals and department records of the project and determined that it appears that no partiality was present in the review of the documents required for code compliance or for the variance required for further compliance.

Code Requirements

4101:7-3-01 (7) (C) Residential and non-residential building department personnel certification.

- (c) Grounds for revocation or suspension. The board shall revoke or suspend an individual's certification if the board concludes that the individual has committed one or more of the following:
 - (iii) Gross negligence, incompetence, misconduct in performance of duties, or engaging in conduct that is considered a conflict of interest;
- (d) Revocation or suspension. In the event of suspension or revocation of a certification, the individual shall no longer hold out to the public or any jurisdiction that the individual is certified to exercise enforcement authority or holds the board certification which has been suspended or certification revoked. During a suspension, the certificate holder shall comply with the training, reporting, auditing, or other remedial action required by the board. In addition to such other authority the board may have, the board is authorized to revoke the individual's certification for failure to comply with such remedial requirements.
- (e) Probationary status. In the event of an investigation in which the board decides not to immediately suspend or revoke an individual's certification, the board may place the individual on probationary status for a period of time and require remedial action as the board deems appropriate. During this time the certificate holder shall comply with the training, reporting, auditing, or other remedial action required by the board. In addition to such other authority the board may have, the board is authorized to revoke or suspend the certificate holder's certification for failure to comply with such remedial requirements.

Conclusion

Board staff, after having reviewed the information, determined that Mr. Bruns had violated the certification rules relating to conflict of interest by not recusing himself from the project which he sealed as the engineer of record, and reviewed as the certified master plan examiner. The civil engineering construction documents provided the basis of that determination.

Recommendations

Board staff recommends closure of the investigation and a disciplinary action of probation requiring attendance of an ethics training class provided by the Ohio Ethics Commission. A certificate of completion shall be required to be submitted to the Board of building standards prior to the end of the probationary period.

A draft of this report was provided to Mr. Bruns on August 11, 2021 for review and comment. Comments received are attached as Appendix A

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to review your Report. Upon review, I have the following two clarifications:

1. In reference to the highlighted portion – last 2 sentences on sheet 2:

Mote and Associates Inc. only completed the Site and Grading Plan. I did not review that plan. That drawing was only reviewed by personnel within the City of Greenville. All drawings that are required for the building permit are being completed and signed/stamped by Pranger Group Inc., including the drawings for the foundation/slab. I did review that plan.

2. In reference to the highlighted portion – third sentence on the top of sheet 3:

Pranger Group Inc. had twice submitted drawings for the foundation/floor slab portion of this project, which I reviewed. Both of these submittals were rejected by me since they were not signed/sealed by a design professional. The third submittal resulted in approval of only the foundation/slab portion of the project since the drawings were signed/sealed by a representative of Pranger Group, Inc.

I now understand a conflict may still arise if I review any part of a project that Mote has worked on, even if the part I am reviewing does not involve Mote drawings. However, I am asking that you make clear in your report that I was not reviewing and approving Mote plans.
