FIRSTENERGY INSTALLATION PROGRAM
Participation Agreement

This Agreement, effective 4-24-07, is made by and between FirstEnergy Service Company ("FirstEnergy"), and VSAT Electrical Contractors L.L.C. ("Contractor").

WHEREAS, FirstEnergy has an Installation Program ("Program") for retail single family and small commercial establishment customers located within FirstEnergy's service territory ("Customers");

WHEREAS, this Program is briefly described as follows:

1. FirstEnergy may provide a loan to a Customer for the purchase of any outdoor lighting system and wiring, electrical installation and service work, heating cooling and ventilation installation and service work, or other equipment and work, that is installed by a participating contractor.
2. Materials must be on FirstEnergy's list of approved equipment for the respective program or a FirstEnergy approved substitute, and installed by a participating contractor in order to qualify.

WHEREAS, Contractor desires to be included on FirstEnergy's list of participating contractors;

WHEREAS, Contractor represents and warrants that it meets the relevant criteria and can provide the work necessary under the terms and conditions specified herein; And

WHEREAS, Contractor agrees to specifically comply with all obligations associated with participation in the Program as more fully described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and agreements of each with the other as herein contained, FirstEnergy and Contractor agree as follows:

Section 1. Contractor's Qualifications and Representations

1.1 Contractor represents and warrants that it will act as an independent contractor (and not as the agent or representative of FirstEnergy) with regard to installation of any outdoor lighting system and wiring, any electrical work, or heating, cooling and ventilation work, or other approved equipment and work, for a Customer (the "Work"). Contractor shall not represent that it is or hold itself out as, an agent or representative of FirstEnergy. In no event shall Contractor be authorized to enter into any agreements or undertakings for or on behalf of FirstEnergy or to act as or be an agent or representative of FirstEnergy.

1.2 FirstEnergy customer information provided under this Agreement is specifically considered proprietary FirstEnergy property and Contractor agrees that it shall not disclose such information to any third party, or utilize the information for any purpose not clearly contemplated by this Agreement, without the prior written authorization of FirstEnergy. Contractor agrees to promptly return FirstEnergy customer information upon request by FirstEnergy. Contractor warrants and agrees that it does not and will not have any conflicts of interest regarding the performance of Work hereunder.

1.3 Contractor agrees that its employees, agents, representatives, subcontractors and suppliers ("Authorized Representatives") will, at all times, conduct themselves in a professional manner toward FirstEnergy, its employees and customers. Contractor shall be fully responsible for the acts, omissions, conduct and performance of its Authorized Representatives. A Quality Survey may be mailed to each customer for whom any Work is performed under this program by FirstEnergy within 30 days of processing the installation invoice.

1.4 Contractor represents that it is, and that at all times during performance of the Work it shall be, fully capable and properly qualified, licensed, equipped, organized and financed to perform the Work.

1.5 That information set forth herein is true and accurate to the best of the knowledge of Contractor.

Section 2. Contractor Program and Finance Procedures

2.1 All customer referrals supplied by the FirstEnergy Marketing Information Center ("FirstEnergy MIC") are to be contacted within five (5) working days (excluding weekends and holidays) to set up an installation and/or scheduled estimate date, which shall be within twenty (20) working days of the referral date.

2.2 All documentation shall include the customer account number and credit approval number which will be supplied by the FirstEnergy MIC at the time of the original referral. If Contractor is contacted directly by a Customer for participation in this Program, Contractor must call the FirstEnergy MIC (1-800-505-7283) and request credit approval for this customer. Credit card approvals will indicate maximum charge available. If the customer requests additional charges above the maximum the contractors will phone MIC for additional credit approvals before proceeding with the installation.

2.3 Any contractor payment request (invoice) that does not have a FirstEnergy MIC credit approval number will not be honored.

2.4 Payment requests for each installation must include a completed and executed Installation Worksheet Form or contractor work order, and when applicable, the Payment Agreement Form (Form X-137), with Contractor's numbered invoice attached. All documentation must be sent to FirstEnergy, Attention: Marketing GHE 408, 76 South Main Street, Akron, OH 44308-1890.

2.5 Any Customer requested extra work not itemized on the contractor program reimbursement schedule shall be pre-approved by FirstEnergy and paid for by the Customer at the time of installation in accordance with the program custom pricing upcharge factor and be included in Contractor's payment request.

Section 3. Work Requests, Performance and Compensation

3.1 FirstEnergy may from time to time request Contractor to perform specific items of Work under this Program. Contractor will perform such requested Work in accordance with generally accepted procedures, practices and standards within the industry and will exercise that degree of skill and judgment commensurate with that which is normally exercised with respect to services of a similar nature and in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

3.2 Upon satisfactory completion of any item of Work, FirstEnergy will compensate Contractor in accordance with Price Schedule. FirstEnergy may at any time revise the Price Schedule which shall be effective when a copy of the revision has been provided to Contractor by FirstEnergy. The compensation for any item of Work shall be based upon the Price Schedule in effect when the item of Work is requested.

3.3 Any payment owed to Contractor pursuant to Section 3.2 shall be subject to offset for any amount owed by Contractor to FirstEnergy.

Section 4. Nonexclusive Agreement

4.1 FirstEnergy will include Contractor on FirstEnergy's list of participating contractors for this Program (Contractor List). Contractor understands and agrees that (1) this is not an exclusive commitment to Contractor by FirstEnergy and (2) as part of its Program, FirstEnergy will sign similar agreements with additional contractors and include such contractors on the Contractor List. Nothing in this Agreement constitutes an agreement by FirstEnergy that any Customer will select Contractor for any Work.

Section 5. Contractor's Performance of Work

5.1 In performing any Work for a Customer under this Program, Contractor shall:

5.1.1 furnish all necessary labor, tools, equipment, materials, transportation, supervision, services and other items required to satisfactorily complete the Work in a timely fashion;

5.1.2 perform the Work in accordance with generally accepted procedures, practices and standards within the industry and exercise that degree of skill and judgment commensurate with that which is normally exercised with respect to services of a similar nature;

5.1.3 comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, codes, rules, licenses, permits, orders, and other requirements, now or hereinafter in effect of any governmental authority including, without limitation, (a) installation or materials standards, (b) requirements relating to contractor licensing, building permits, zoning and consumer protection, and (c) workers' compensation and employer's liability insurance; any costs necessary to comply with this provision shall be to the Contractor's account;

5.1.4 provide Customer with a written warranty and guarantee which contains the language set forth in Section 10 of this Agreement and copies of all manufacturer's warranties relating to the Work;

5.1.5 take all precautions necessary to prevent bodily harm or property damage in connection with the Work;

5.1.6 ensure that only experienced and properly qualified persons perform the Work; and

5.1.7 promptly and satisfactorily correct all defects or deficiencies in the Work as identified by Customer or FirstEnergy within five (5) working days of being notified of the defect. If Contractor fails or refuses to make such correction, FirstEnergy may, at its option, make such correction at Contractor's expense, which shall be promptly paid by Contractor or offset against any payments owed to Contractor.

5.1.8 satisfactorily repair all damages caused by Contractor to Customer's property, at Contractor's expense, within thirty (30) days of the date upon which the damage occurred. If Contractor fails or refuses to make such correction, FirstEnergy may, at its option, make such correction at Contractor's expense, which shall be promptly paid by Contractor or offset against any payments owed to Contractor.

5.2 The Work shall at all times be subject to inspection and testing by Customer and FirstEnergy. It is hereby agreed and understood that FirstEnergy does not assume any obligation or responsibility to perform or review any inspection or testing.

5.3 Contractor shall promptly pay and secure the discharge of any liens asserted by all persons and entities (including, but not limited to, Contractor's subcontractors, suppliers and employees) furnishing labor, equipment, materials or other items in connection with the performance of the Work. Contractor shall furnish to FirstEnergy such releases of claims and other documents as may be requested by FirstEnergy from time to time to evidence such payment and discharge. FirstEnergy may withhold all or part of the payment otherwise payable under this Agreement to Contractor until such documents are so furnished. If any of such persons or entities are not promptly paid or if any of such liens are not promptly discharged, FirstEnergy may, at its option, make such payments and secure such discharge. Contractor agrees to promptly reimburse FirstEnergy for all expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by FirstEnergy related to the discharge of such lien(s). FirstEnergy shall also have the right to offset any amount due it against any amount due Contractor.

5.4 Contractor shall provide FirstEnergy, at FirstEnergy's request, with any information or records pertaining to Contractor qualifications, representations or performance under this Agreement.

Section 6. Term, Termination and Survival

6.1 This Agreement shall commence on the day and year first above written and shall continue for one (1) year. This Agreement may be extended by written mutual agreement of the Parties for up to two additional one (1) year periods. FirstEnergy may terminate this Agreement, without recourse from Contractor, with or without cause, by providing written notice to Contractor of the effective date of termination. Contractor may terminate this Agreement by giving written notice to FirstEnergy at least thirty (30) days in advance of the effective date of termination. If Contractor terminates this Agreement, then Contractor shall immediately inform all Customers that Contractor is no longer on the Contractor List, and that Customer will not qualify for financial assistance from FirstEnergy regarding the Work if Contractor is employed. FirstEnergy shall not be obligated to provide any financial assistance with regard to work begun after the date of termination. FirstEnergy shall not be liable for any loss of revenue or profit or other damages incurred by Contractor as result of such termination.

6.2 Contractor's obligations under Sections 5, 8, 9 and 10 herein shall survive termination of this Agreement.

Section 7. FirstEnergy's Financial Assistance to Customer

7.1 In order to qualify for financial assistance, a Customer: (i) must be a customer of FirstEnergy or be credit approved to be invoiced by FirstEnergy; (ii) must be owner of the single family dwelling where the equipment will be installed; (iii) must be the owner or agent authorized agent of eligible commercial property; (iv) must have acceptable credit with FirstEnergy. A Customer meeting these criteria may finance the installation of the equipment without interest upon the execution of the Payment Agreement Form (Form X-137.)

7.2 If Work is to be financed by a FirstEnergy loan to the Customer, Contractor will not start the Work until (a) the Contractor has completed the Payment Agreement form (Form X-137) provided by FirstEnergy, (b) the Payment Agreement has been signed by the owner (or authorized representative of the owner) of the premises where the Work is to be performed, (c) a copy of the completed and signed Payment Agreement has been left with the owner, and (d) the loan has been approved by FirstEnergy. The Payment Agreement will indicate the amount of financial assistance available from FirstEnergy under the Program.

7.3 Upon satisfactory completion of the Work and FirstEnergy's receipt of a properly completed and signed Payment Agreement, FirstEnergy will issue a check in the amount of financial assistance allowed under the Program, subject to its right of set off. The check shall be payable to Contractor on behalf of Customer. FirstEnergy shall have no obligation whatsoever to extend any financial assistance if, in its opinion, Work has not been satisfactorily completed, if the Payment Agreement has not been properly completed and signed, or if Customer does not otherwise qualify for such financial assistance.

Section 8. Indemnity

8.1 Contractor, for itself, its successors, assigns and subcontractors, agrees to pay, indemnify and save FirstEnergy Corp., its successors and assigns, harmless from and against any and all court costs and litigation expenses, including legal fees, incurred or related to the defense of any action asserted by any person or persons for bodily injuries, death or property damage arising or in any manner growing out of the work performed or to be performed under this Agreement.

8.2 Contractor for itself, its successors, assigns and subcontractors, agrees to pay, indemnify and save FirstEnergy Corp., its successors and assigns, harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action, together with any and all losses, in connection therewith or related thereto, asserted by any person or persons for bodily injuries, death or property damage arising or in any manner growing out of the work performed or to be performed under this contract, unless initiated or proximately caused by or resulting from the sole negligence of FirstEnergy.

8.3 Contractor for itself, its successors, assigns and subcontractors, agrees to pay, indemnify and hold FirstEnergy Corp., its successors and assigns, harmless against all fines, penalties, costs or losses incurred for or by reason of the violation by Contractor or subcontractor in the performance of this Agreement, of any ordinance, regulation, rule or law of the United States or any political subdivision or duly constituted public authority.

8.4 Contractor for itself, its successors, assigns and subcontractors, does hereby waive, as a complying employer, any immunity provided for under the law of the State of Ohio pertaining to Workers' Compensation for the sole purpose of enforcing this indemnification provision between Contractor and FirstEnergy.

Section 9. Insurance

9.1 Contractor shall, at its expense, procure and maintain in effect at all times during the performance of any Work pursuant to this Agreement, the insurance specified below and provide FirstEnergy evidence of the following:

9.1.1 Statutory Workers' Compensation.

9.1.2 Comprehensive General Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, combined single limit, for bodily injury and property damage.

9.1.3 Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance including nonownership and hired-car endorsement with minimum limits of \$500,000 per occurrence, combined single limit, for bodily injury and property damage.

9.1.4 FirstEnergy shall be named as an additional insured, it being understood that said policies shall provide primary insurance to FirstEnergy.

9.1.5 Each Certificate of Insurance shall be endorsed in the following terms: "This insurance coverage will not be canceled or allowed to lapse, and no change shall be made in this policy which alters, restricts, or reduces the insurance provided or changes the name of the insured without first giving at least thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Risk Management Department of FirstEnergy Corp. at its office in Akron, Ohio with receipt of notice acknowledged."

9.2 The foregoing requirements as to insurance are not intended to and shall not in any manner limit or qualify Contractor's liabilities and obligations under this Agreement.

Section 10. Warranty and Guarantee

10.1 Contractor, for itself, its successors and permitted assigns and subcontractors warrants that (1) it will perform the Work in a professional and workmanlike manner free from all faults and defects in workmanship, materials, design and title, and in conformance with the requirements of this Agreement, and (2) the Work will comply with any recommended installation procedures of the manufacturer. Contractor, for itself, its successors and permitted assigns and subcontractors, further covenants that it will cure all such faults and defects without cost to FirstEnergy or Customer for a period of one year following date of completion of installation. **FIRSTENERGY MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, REGARDING THE EQUIPMENT INSTALLED UNDER THIS PROGRAM REGARDING MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

Section 11. Confidentiality

11.1 Contractor acknowledges that the disclosure of certain confidential and proprietary information belonging to FirstEnergy, including but not limited to, proprietary pricing information, customer lists and any other information designated by FirstEnergy as confidential and propriety, will occur during the performance of the Work hereunder. Contractor agrees to comply with the following procedures regarding such confidential and proprietary information.

- a. Contractor shall not disclose such confidential or proprietary information to a third party with first obtaining written consent from FirstEnergy.
- b. Contractor shall not use FirstEnergy confidential or propriety information for its own competitive advantage outside of its participation in the Program.
- c. Contractor shall not reproduce such confidential or proprietary information without the prior consent of FirstEnergy.
- d. Contractor shall return all such confidential and proprietary information to FirstEnergy upon termination of this Participation Agreement.

Section 12. Assignment and Subcontractors

12.1 Contractor shall neither assign this Agreement nor subcontract any of the Work to be performed hereunder without the prior written consent of FirstEnergy. Any assignment or subcontracting that is so consented to by FirstEnergy shall not relieve Contractor from its warranties and obligations under this Agreement.

Section 13. Attorneys' Fees Upon Default or Breach

13.1 If Contractor fails to comply with any of the terms or conditions contained herein, FirstEnergy may withhold payment for any Work until such defect is cured to FirstEnergy's satisfaction. Such shall not limit any other rights or remedies available to FirstEnergy.

13.2 If Contractor defaults in timely performance of its obligations under this Agreement or in any way breaches this Agreement, FirstEnergy shall be entitled to recover in any suit or proceeding to enforce its rights under this Agreement court costs and litigation costs including reasonable attorneys' fees. The foregoing shall not in any way limit or restrict any right or remedy at law or equity which would otherwise be available to FirstEnergy.

13.3 If Contractor fails to comply with the provisions of Section 11.1 of this Agreement, FirstEnergy shall immediately terminate this Agreement and pursue all rights and remedies available to it under law and equity. In addition, FirstEnergy shall be entitled to recover from Contractor all costs and fees described in Section 13.2 above.

Section 14. Enforcement by Customers

14.1 Contractor agrees that the warranties and representations herein made by it are for the benefit both FirstEnergy and its Customers participating in FirstEnergy's Program. Therefore, Contractor agrees that any Customer having a contract with a Contractor under FirstEnergy's Program may rely upon the warranties and representations made by Contractor in this Agreement and may, with FirstEnergy's consent, directly pursue the rights and remedies hereunder in the event of breach of default by Contractor. However, any representations made by or enforcement actions taken by a Customer shall not in any way limit or impair the rights and remedies of FirstEnergy under this Agreement or by law. Contractor fully understands that Customer does not in any way or at any time constitute FirstEnergy's representative or agent.

Section 15. Equal Opportunity

15.1 Contractor shall comply, with all Federal, State and Local Laws and regulations governing labor or employee relations, including but not limited to Sections 6, 7, 12 and 14 of the Fair Labor Standards Act, as amended. When appropriate the following affirmative action clauses are incorporated herein by reference: the handicapped clause in 48 CFR 52.222 - 36, the disabled veterans and veterans of the Vietnam Era in 48 CFR 52.222 - 35, and the utilization of Small Business and Small Disadvantaged Business in 48 CFR 52.219 - 9. If applicable to the performance of this Agreement, the Contractor will comply with all provisions of Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965 and with all rules, regulations, and relevant orders of the Secretary of Labor promulgated with regard to said Order. Further, all provisions of such Order which are mandatory for inclusion in this Agreement are specifically incorporated herein by reference as if fully stated herein.

Section 16. Miscellaneous

16.1 The rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be subject to and governed by this Agreement. This Agreement sets forth the entire Agreement of the parties and supersedes any and all prior Agreements with respect to the subject matter contained herein. This Agreement may not be modified except by writing executed by authorized agents of both parties.

16.2 This Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall be governed by the laws of the State of Ohio.

16.3 The failure or delay of FirstEnergy to either (1) insist upon strict performance of any of the provisions of this Agreement or (2) exercise any rights or remedies provided in this Agreement or by law, as well as the making of any payment to Contractor, shall not release or relieve Contractor from any of its obligations or warranties under this Agreement and shall not be deemed a waiver of any right of FirstEnergy to insist upon strict performance of this Agreement or any of the rights or remedies of FirstEnergy hereunder.
