Call to Order and Roll Call

The Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting of the Palos Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Schumann in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, at 7:04 P.M. Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisor Schuman led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Disposition of Minutes from Previous Meeting

a. Approval of Minutes of the Combined Bill Audit and Road District Meeting March 26, 2018.

Trustee Woods moved to approve the minutes of the March 26, 2028, Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting. **Trustee Riley** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken: Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Special Presentations/Communications

There were no special presentations or communications at this meeting.

Reports of Officials

a. Supervisor

1. Consideration of Cost of Living Increase for Staff

Supervisor Schumann informed the Board that at present COLA is 2.1%. The township has budgeted 3% for the employees Cost of Living raise this year.

There was a discussion concerning this topic.

Trustee Woods moved to allow the Supervisor Schumann to choose between the 2.1 COLA and the 3% Cost of Living increase budgeted for the year. **Trustee Jeanes** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, Riley ad Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Supervisor Schumann stated that **Highway Commissioner Adams** and **Assessor Maloney** will have to decide the Cost of Living increases for their employees.

b. Clerk

1. Attendance for TOCC Spring Conference

Clerk Nolan inquired as to which Trustees would be attending the TOCC Spring along with Supervisor Schumann, Clerk Nolan, Highway Commissioner Adams, and Assessor Maloney.

Trustee Riley will attend along with Administrative Assistant to the Supervisor, Mary Wallenburg ,and Administrative Assistant to the Highway Commissioner, April Schrader.

2. Statements of Economic Interest

Clerk Nolan reported that all Statements of Economic Interest from Palos Township have been filed by the May 1, 2018, deadline.

c. Highway Commissioner

Highway Commissioner Adams informed the Board that patching has been ongoing throughout the township. He is currently negotiating with the engineer concerning new construction.

He is also calling contractors for ideas for the township parking lot renovation. There was not much money round when the township building was first built. He will advertise for more bids for the project. The specifications for the bids are drawn up by the engineer. Patching and re-patching is not the answer to the problem. Some estimates for the project has been given to the township.

There is an electrical problem which will be addressed soon. Also, the entire front handicapped entrance will be redone.

Supervisor Schumann moved to approve the audit of the General Assistance Bills and Warrants. **Trustee Woods** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.

b. Policy and Personnel – Supervisor Schumann

Supervisor Schumann reported that the township may have to be closed during the parking lot renovation.

Trustee Riley stated that he had no report for the Board.

d. Buildings and Grounds – Trustee Jeanes
